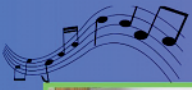

Thoughts from Fr. Tom

This year, our annual observance of **All Souls Day** falls on a Sunday so it takes precedence over the Sunday in Ordinary Time and we celebrate it at all the weekend Masses. **The Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed** is a time for us to offer prayers for the deceased and to remember our prayers can be of assistance to the dead and their sharing in the Resurrection of Jesus. We are reminded in the Gospel by Jesus that it is God's desire that all people share in eternal life. Jesus said: **For this is the will of my Father, that everyone who sees the Son and believes in him may have eternal life, and I shall raise him up on the last day.** Since the earliest centuries of the Christian faith, believers have found hope even in death because of their faith in the Risen Christ. May our hope be reflected in our prayers for our departed loved ones and all the deceased and our trust in Christ's promise of eternal life.

We extend a special welcome this weekend to those gathered with us who have lost a loved one this past year and those who are joining us for our **Remembrance Masses**. As we announce the names of the deceased, we lift them up in prayer and remember the bonds of love they have shared with us and trust that those bonds never die. At every funeral Mass we celebrate in the parish, one of the family members of the deceased places the name of their loved one in our **Book of Remembrance**. This is a way for our parish community to hold the deceased in our hearts and prayers throughout the year. November is designated as a special time in our Church to remember those who have died, so it is fitting for us to honor the names of the deceased. The *Book of Remembrance* will be displayed throughout the month of November by the baptismal font. You are invited to place the names of your deceased loved ones in the book. As you pass by the Book of Remembrance each week, take time to say a special prayer for the names listed on the pages. Our prayers unite us to those who have gone before us and keep us mindful of the gift of heaven.

Please remember that we are in the midst of our annual **Stewardship Renewal**. Over the next couple of weeks, you will hear about the call to be good stewards of God's gifts and to share them generously with our faith community. We ask that you please take time to fill out the Stewardship forms and to make a commitment of your **time, talent, and treasure** for the coming year. Please return your commitment forms the weekend of November 15-16. Our hope is to not only raise awareness but also increase participation in the Stewardship Renewal. Please take time to prayerfully reflect on how God is calling you.

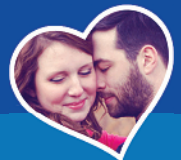
