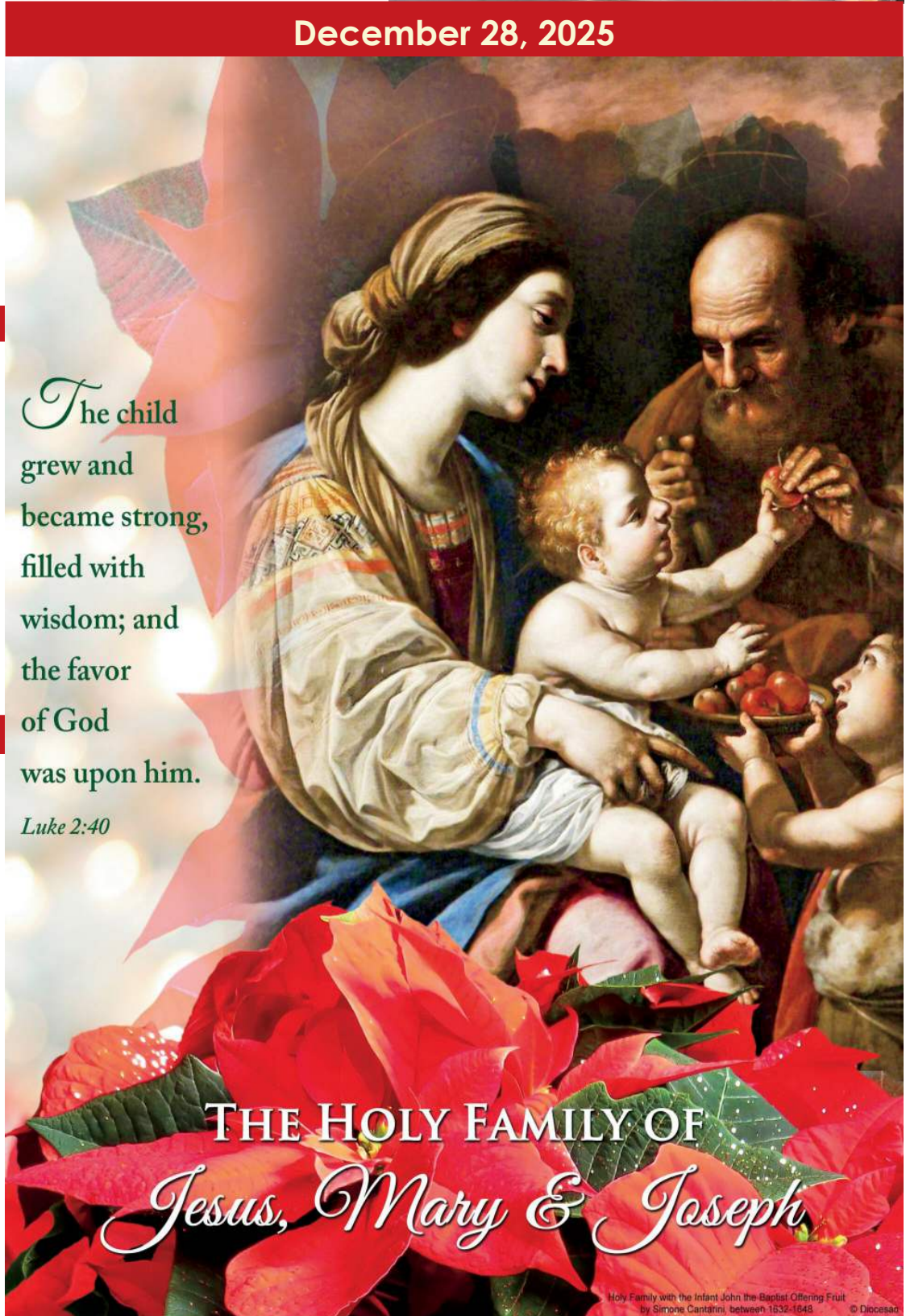

MERRY CHRISTMAS! We continue to rejoice in the birth of Christ and the miracle of God becoming one of us. I hope your celebrations of Christmas Eve and Day were blessed ones. We Catholic Christians celebrate Christmas as a whole season, until the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord, which is January 11 this year. Even if you are taking your lights and Christmas decorations down soon, consider leaving up your Nativity scene or some other visual reminder of Christmas until the end of the season. We want to spread the joy and share the light of Christ's birth throughout the season.

This weekend within the Octave of Christmas we celebrate the **Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph**. This feast, celebrated by the universal Church, is rooted in the devotion the faithful have had to the Holy Family for many centuries. 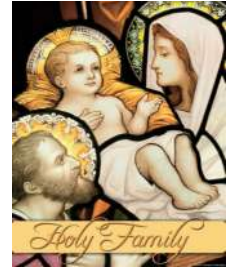
