## Epiphany Blessing of the Home

This year, we celebrate Epiphany on January 4. On the feast of the Epiphany, it is traditional to bless homes, including passageways and doorways.

Often associated with these blessings is a ritual of "chalking" the home's doors with the year's numbers separated by the initials CMB. The letters traditionally refer to the legendary names of the three kings: Caspar, Melchior, and Balthasar. Another tradition refers to it as the abbreviation of the Latin phrase, *Christus mansionem benedicat*, translated as "May Christ bless this house."

To bless your home, use chalk and mark 20+C+M+B+26 on the lintel of your door, saying: Caspar, Melchior, and Balthasar followed the star of God's Son who became human 2024 years ago. May Christ bless our home and remain with us throughout the new year. Amen.

# Thoughts from Fr. Tom

**HAPPY NEW YEAR!** As we enter 2026, may the light that came into our world through the birth of Jesus continue to shine brightly in our lives throughout the year. We continue our celebration of the Christmas season today with the **Feast of the Epiphany of the Lord**. The familiar story of the magi from the east following the star that leads them to Jesus is an epiphany that reveals Jesus as the Savior for all humankind. This is a great feast for the beginning of the new year because it reminds us who we are called to follow. Jesus is the light who overcomes the darkness in our lives. Jesus is the One who fulfills all our hopes and dreams. As we make our resolutions for the new year, I hope all of us will commit every day to share the light of our faith with others and be bold in living our call to follow Jesus.

The **Feast of the Epiphany** is the traditional time for the  **blessing of homes**. As we have done in past years, we are providing blessed chalk and a simple blessing for your home with instructions for marking your doorway. The marking includes the first initial of the traditional names for the three magi – *Caspar, Melchior, and Balthasar* – and the numbers for the year. This year it would read **20+ C + M + B + 26**. As we come and go from our homes we are reminded of Christ's presence and dedicate ourselves to being his presence for others. It's a great conversation piece.

Thank you to those who contributed to our **Year-End Giving** fund in support of our Bell Tower project. We are grateful for the generous donations of so many that will make this project possible. We will plan to begin the project this spring when the weather is more consistent and will look forward to the bell from St. Mary's, the original parish in Lee's Summit that became Our Lady of the Presentation, having a proper place on our campus. And special thanks to those who support the Future Projects Fund throughout the year.

Next weekend we bring the Christmas season to a close with the **Feast of the Baptism of the Lord**. Be sure to focus on ways you can keep the spirit of Christmas alive throughout the year by sharing your faith in the new year.

As many of you know, we handed out the book **33 Days to Eucharistic Glory** at our Christmas Masses. The book is a spiritual pilgrimage of sorts over the 33 reflections, "Days", in the book. The book makes the point that the most effective way to keep people from leaving the church,

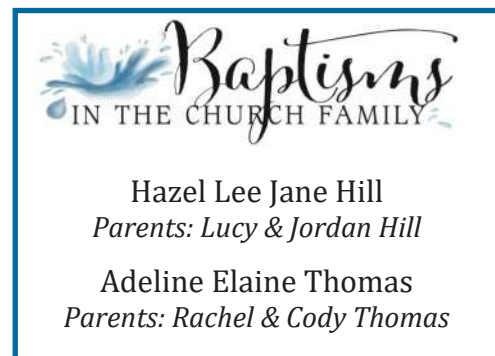

## Jesús es el Señor y Salvador

Queridos hermanos y hermanas, continuamos celebrando la Navidad. Este domingo se llama Domingo de la Epifanía. La palabra "epifanía" significa "resplandor", "aparición" o manifestación. Esto se refiere a la revelación de la divinidad de Jesús al mundo entero. Está simbolizada por la visita de los tres reyes magos: Gaspar, Melchor y Baltasar. Gaspar trajo un regalo de oro; Melchor, incienso; y Baltasar, mirra a Jesús. Estos magos denotan que la salvación de Dios es para todos los pueblos.

Los tres regalos son característicos del ministerio de Jesús. El oro es el regalo para un rey. El oro se considera el rey de los metales, un regalo ideal para un rey de hombres. Así como los Reyes Magos se sometieron a la realeza de Jesús, también nosotros estamos llamados a someter nuestros corazones y vidas a Él.

El incienso es un don sacerdotal. Se usa en la iglesia para el culto y para incensar los sacrificios en la oración. Este regalo significa que Jesús es un sacerdote cuya función es ayudar al pueblo de Dios necesitado mediante la oración. Jesús es el que construye puentes entre los hombres y Dios.

La mirra es el don para quien va a morir. La mirra se usa para embalsamar los cuerpos de los muertos. Esto significa que Jesús vino al mundo para vivir y morir por las personas al final de su vida. Jesús nació para dar su vida por los hombres y su muerte para salvar a todas las personas, permitiéndoles nacer en el Reino eterno de Dios.

Por lo tanto, la visita de los magos simboliza que todos estamos invitados a ser coherederos del reino de Jesús y que somos adoptados en las promesas de Dios, participando en el ministerio sacerdotal, real y profético de Jesús.

Así como estos hombres buscaron a Jesús guiados por la estrella, también nosotros debemos buscar a Dios dejándonos guiar por Jesús, luz eterna y palabra viva de Dios entre nosotros. De ahora en adelante presentemos a Jesús a nuestros hermanos y hermanas en nuestras obras de amor.

Seamos hermanos y amigos eternos en Cristo y en la Santísima Virgen María.
