Thoughts from Fr. Tom

In today's Gospel from Matthew, we hear about the beginning of Jesus' public ministry. After John the Baptist was arrested we are told: **From that time on, Jesus began to preach and say, 'Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.'** From the beginning of his ministry, Jesus called others to follow him. In today's passage, Jesus calls Peter and Andrew and **at once they left their nets and followed him.** Jesus then calls James and John and **immediately they left their boat and their father and followed him.** The call of Jesus to these brothers comes amid their daily activities and their response to follow him is immediate. They did not know where the journey would lead or what the future would hold, but they trusted. The call to follow Jesus continues to come in our daily lives and activities. We know responding to the call of Jesus will lead to fulfillment and deeper meaning in our lives, but often the busyness and distractions in our lives keep us from giving ourselves fully to Christ. May we listen to Christ's voice and find ways each day to follow him more closely.

This weekend begins the annual celebration of **Catholic Schools Week.** This is a time to celebrate the gift of Catholic education in our country and for parishes in particular to recognize the on-going commitment to provide a quality, faith-based education to our children. Many of our school families and staff will be present at the Masses this weekend helping with ministries. Our parish has been blessed with a strong commitment to Catholic education for many decades. Every school day we have about 750 children on our campus attending either our parish grade school or Early Childhood Center (ECC). Our ability to provide quality programs rooted in our Catholic faith is made possible by the support of our entire parish community. This weekend is a time to give thanks to all of you and your practice of stewardship. We are also grateful for the families who send their children to our school and ECC, many of whom make sacrifices to do so. We are grateful for our dedicated staff and teachers and our Principal, Marianne Organ, and ECC Director, Teresa Button, who share their gifts with our children each day. And we are especially grateful for the joy, life, and love all the children of our parish bring to our community. They are a constant reminder of God's presence.

There are displays in the Gathering Space about our school and students and their families will also be handing out cookies-to-go as a token of appreciation. Please continue to share the good news of Catholic education with those you know.

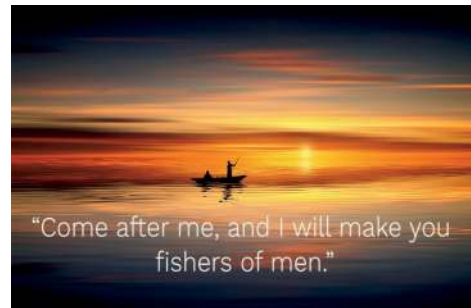

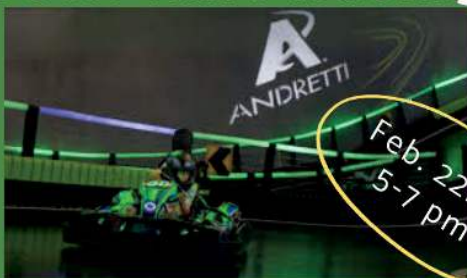

Jesús es la luz de mi vida

Queridos hermanos y hermanas, hoy celebramos el tercer domingo del Tiempo Ordinario, ciclo A. Se llama: Domingo de la Palabra de Dios. El Papa Francisco declaró que esta semana se dedique a la celebración, el estudio y la divulgación de la Palabra de Dios para que crezcamos en el conocimiento y el amor de las Escrituras. También hoy concluimos nuestra semana de oración por la unidad de los cristianos.

Las lecturas de hoy nos dicen: "El Señor es mi luz." La luz en la Biblia representa muchas cosas; por ejemplo, significa iluminación espiritual, comprensión y salvación. Naturalmente, sabemos que la luz revela las cosas ocultas en la oscuridad. Al igual que los israelitas en la oscuridad después de la derrota ante Asiria, el profeta Isaías usa la luz para significar que la redención de Israel por parte de Dios está cerca. El Mesías vendría y sacaría a su pueblo de la oscuridad, y el pueblo vería una gran luz. El Mesías sanaría a las personas de sus pecados y traería unidad y paz a Israel.

El Mesías profetizado es Jesucristo, la Gran Luz. Comienza su ministerio público en Galilea como una luz que amanece en la oscura región de Zabulón y

Neftalí, territorio de gentiles, predicando principalmente la llegada del Reino de los Cielos y llamando a la gente al arrepentimiento.

La palabra arrepentimiento tiene varios significados entre los griegos. Significaba: apartarse del pecado; cambiar de rumbo; cambiar de comportamiento, de actitud y cambiar de vida.

Por lo tanto, Jesús es la luz de Dios para el pueblo que camina en la oscuridad. Es la luz para un pueblo oprimido por varias razones en lo espiritual, lo social y políticamente. Jesús es la gran luz, que ilumina la presencia de Dios entre su pueblo, su gente y los guía a la salvación.

Necesitamos urgentemente acoger a Jesús en nuestras vidas como nuestra luz. Y también necesitamos transmitir esta luz del Señor a los demás. Podemos responder a este llamado participando en diferentes ministerios en la comunidad parroquial. Al igual que los primeros discípulos que respondieron a la invitación de Jesús a seguirlo sin dudarlo, nosotros también estamos llamados a responder a la invitación que Jesús nos hace, mientras realizamos nuestras tareas cotidianas, y sin poner excusas. Seamos hermanos y amigos eternos en Cristo y en la Santísima Virgen María.
