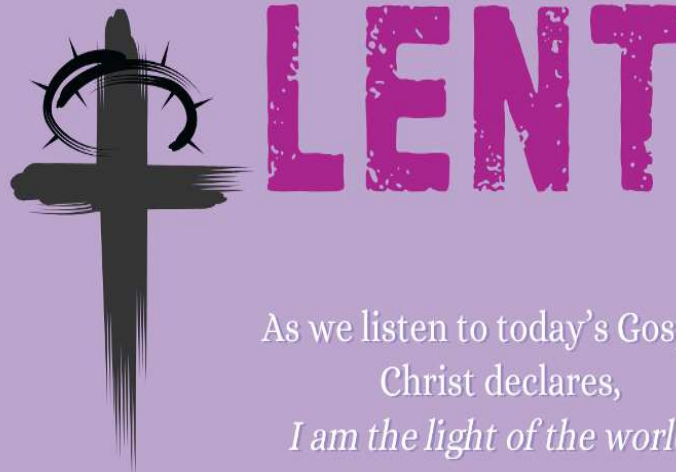

Thoughts from Fr. Tom

In the Gospel this weekend, Jesus opens the eyes of a man born blind. The story begins with the disciples asking Jesus: **Rabbi, who sinned, this man or his parents, that he was born blind?** Jesus quickly dispels this commonly held belief of his time by saying that neither sinned. The mercy of God that Jesus shares turns everything upside down and allows those who experience it to see everything differently. Jesus goes further by saying that the **works of God** will be made visible through the healing of the blind man and help reveal Jesus as the **light of the world**. This powerful story is an invitation for all of us to see with the eyes of faith. Most of us will never have to deal with physical blindness. We can even take our physical sight for granted, but spiritual blindness is something that affects all of us at times. This season of Lent is a time for our eyes to be opened so that we may recognize the presence of Jesus in our midst and become a visible sign for others of Christ's presence.

This week in the Catholic Church we celebrate a couple of important saints in our tradition. This Tuesday, March 17, is **St. Patrick's Day** and this Thursday, March 19, is **St. Joseph's Day**. A number of popular customs and devotions have developed over the years to honor these saints. But let's remember the example of service both of these saints provide for us. St. Patrick left his homeland to spread the gospel in a foreign land and St. Joseph risked his own reputation to lead and protect the Holy Family. Do something to serve others this week in celebration of St. Patrick and St. Joseph.

Next weekend, Vincentian Father Ron Hoyer, the priest leading our upcoming **Parish Mission** will be preaching at all the Masses and encouraging our parishioners to attend the Mission evenings. Please mark your calendars to attend the Mission at 6:30 p.m. on Sunday, March 22; Monday, March 23; and Tuesday, March 24. The theme for the Mission is **Pray-Serve-Be Kind-Let Go!** These are great things for us to reflect on during Lent and in preparation for Easter. Fr. Hoyer is a well-known and engaging presenter and has given parish missions all over the country. Feel free to invite family members and friends to attend. Let's commit to being together for the Mission as use it as an opportunity to strengthen our faith life and grow as a community.

About 100 middle school youth (mostly 6th graders) from our parish will celebrate the **Sacrament of Confirmation** next Sunday, March 22, with Bishop Johnston at the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception. Beginning this year, the Bishop has asked that all celebrations of Confirmation take place at the Cathedral. We also had a smaller group of older middle school and high school youth celebrate the Sacrament a couple of weeks ago. Please keep these young people in your prayers.

Jesús es la luz del mundo

Queridos hermanos y hermanas, ya estamos en el Cuarto Domingo de Cuaresma. Este domingo se llama Domingo Laetare, que significa Domingo de Alegría. Nos alegramos porque Jesús, la luz del mundo, ha venido para que las obras de Dios se hagan visibles a través de él. Nuestras lecturas provienen de 1 Samuel 16:1-13; Efesios 5:8-14 y el evangelio es según Juan 9:1-41.

Las lecturas de hoy se centran en el tema de la luz, la vista y la ceguera. Dios le dice al profeta Samuel **“Dios no ve como el hombre ve ...”**. San Pablo recuerda **“somos luz en el Señor y debemos vivir como hijos de la luz”**, y en el Evangelio, Jesús sana a un hombre ciego de nacimiento, devolviéndole la vista. Rechaza la idea común de la época de que el sufrimiento es resultado del pecado personal, destacando que algunas enfermedades y aflicciones son permitidas para manifestar la gloria de Dios. También condena a los fariseos que persisten en su pecado y alaba al ciego que reconoce que Jesús da luz y vista.

Durante esta Cuaresma, reflexionemos sobre cómo nos negamos a comprometernos con Cristo y su misión. Le pido a cada uno de ustedes; enfrenta el mie-

do interior que te impide dejar que Cristo te dé una nueva visión en tu camino de fe.

Es importante que seamos conscientes de la manera en que permanecemos ciegos a la presencia de Dios. Presta atención a Jesús, que viene a devolver la luz a nuestras vidas cuando todo a nuestro alrededor nos parece estar en tinieblas.

Quiero invitarles a considerar vivir como si esta fuera tu única Cuaresma. Desconoces la próxima Cuaresma. Aprovecha estas diferentes actividades espirituales en la parroquia para preparar tu vida espiritual. Lo más importante es planear y asistir al sacramento de la reconciliación. Tenemos confesiones este lunes a partir de las 6pm. Varios sacerdotes estarán disponibles para ayudarnos. Además, coordinen asistir a nuestro retiro de fin de semana de la Misión Parroquial los días 21 y 22 de marzo.

Ahora somos **“Luz en el Señor”** (Efesios 5:8). Y que nuestra oración sea: **“¡Jesús, tú eres mi luz! Ayúdame a dejar que tu luz brille a través de mí”**.

Seamos hermanos y amigos eternos en Cristo y la Santísima Virgen María.

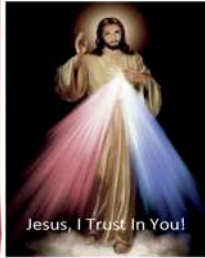
