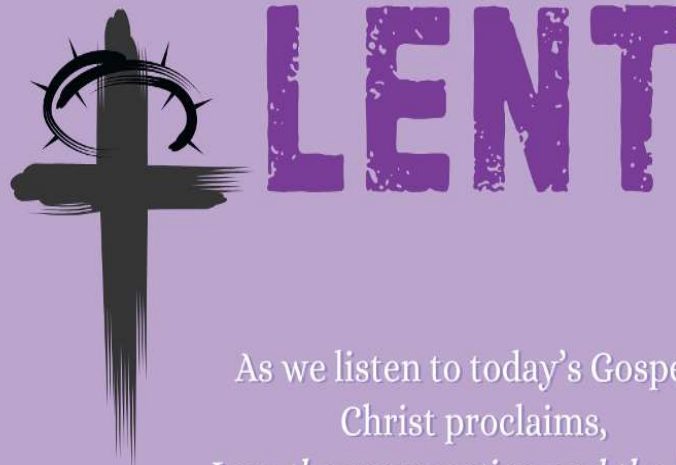

Thoughts from Fr. Tom

The Gospel for this **5th Sunday of Lent** is the story of **Lazarus being raised from the dead**. This story shows forth Jesus' humanity as he weeps at the death of his friend Lazarus and tries to bring comfort to Lazarus' sisters, Martha and Mary. He is even referred to as being perturbed a couple of times in the story at the impatience of others. But the story also shows forth the extraordinary power of God at work in Jesus. He is able to call Lazarus out of the tomb and restore his life. This story is a foretaste of Christ's Resurrection when death is conquered for all through the life of Jesus. This story also reminds us that through Christ, whatever is dead within us, whatever needs new life, can be restored through him. If we are honest with ourselves, all of us have areas in our life that need to be restored and renewed. As we enter this last full week of Lent, may we be led to a deeper trust in the freedom and new life that only comes through Christ.

This weekend we welcome Vincentian *Father Ron Hoye* to our Masses. He will be preaching at the Masses and encouraging you to attend our **Lenten Parish Mission** that begins this Sunday, March 22 at 6:30 p.m. and continues Monday and Tuesday at 6:30 p.m. Please mark your calendars to join us and invite family and friends to join you. The theme for the Mission is **Pray-Serve-Be Kind-Let Go!** These are great things for us to reflect on during Lent and in preparation for Easter. Let's commit to being together for the Mission.

Thank you to everyone who supported our parish **St. Joseph Table** a couple of weeks ago. A special thanks to **Francesca Gill and her family** for coordinating all the details and for all the volunteers who helped cook, bake, and support the event. All the proceeds from this wonderful tradition will support our service partner Uplift.

Next weekend, March 28-29, we will begin **Holy Week** with our celebration of **Palm Sunday**. This is one of the times during the year when Mass begins differently. Weather permitting, we will begin outside on the south side parking lot for our Masses for the blessing of palms. JESÚS ES NUESTRA VIDA

Queridos amigos, nos encontramos en el quinto domingo de Cuaresma. Nuestras lecturas provienen de Ezequiel 37:12-14 y Romanos 8:8-11; y el Evangelio es según San Juan 11:1-45.

Durante los últimos tres domingos, el evangelista Juan nos ha estado revelando la divinidad de Cristo. Utilizó tres signos para revelar a la humanidad quién es Jesús. Dijo que Jesús es el agua viva que da la vida eterna; que Jesús es la luz del mundo; y hoy, declara a Jesús como nuestra resurrección y nuestra vida.

Jesús, como aquel que devuelve la vida, se revela a través de la resurrección de Lázaro de entre los muertos. Este acto manifestó que Jesús posee el poder de su Padre celestial para mostrar su gloria. A través de este signo, Jesús nos habla a ti y a mí, quienes lidiamos con el misterio de la Muerte, tal como se hace eco en las palabras de Marta y María: **“Señor, si hubieras estado aquí, mi hermano no habría Muerto.”**

Jesús les responde declarando: **“Yo soy la resurrección y la vida; el que cree en mí, aunque muera, vivirá; y todo aquel que vive y cree en mí, no morirá jamás. ¿Crees esto?”**

La pregunta de Marta se aplica a todas las personas. La muerte de un ser querido nos sumerge en una profun-

da oscuridad existencial. Es como si la luz se apagara. Nos toma algunos instantes, si no días volver a ver con claridad. Luchamos entre el duelo y la esperanza. **¿Creemos que Jesús es la resurrección y la vida?**

La respuesta final de Marta, tras su diálogo con Jesús, me conmueve profundamente. Es tan poderosa que debe llevarnos a profesar nuestra fe en Cristo: **“Sí, Señor. He llegado a creer que tú eres el Cristo, el Hijo de Dios, el que ha de venir al mundo.”**

Nuestro camino cuaresmal debe conducirnos a esta decisión fundamental de fe: que Jesús es el Cristo, el Mesías, el Hijo de Dios; y que Jesús ha sido enviado por el Padre para restaurar la vida humana, librándola de la muerte causada por el mal. Solo en Jesús podemos hallar la redención.

En Jesús reside el poder vivificante de Dios para la humanidad. Esforcémonos, pues, por vivir en el espíritu de aquel que resucitó a Jesús de entre los muertos; Él dará vida también a nuestros cuerpos mortales.

Recuerden que esta tarde damos inicio a nuestra **Misión Parroquial** de tres días, con charlas que se llevarán a cabo en el templo a las **6:30 p.m.** cada día. Concluiremos el martes 24. Por favor, procuren asistir; espero verlos a todos. Oren por nuestros niños que se preparan para recibir sus Primeras Comuniones. Seamos hermanos y amigos eternos en Cristo y en la Santísima Virgen María.
