Thoughts from Fr. Tom

The Gospel for today begins with Jesus saying: **Do not let your hearts be troubled. You have faith in God, have faith also in me.** Do we allow our faith in God to comfort us when we are feeling troubled? Jesus reminds us that nothing can overwhelm us if we place our trust in him. Jesus goes on to say: **In my Father's house there are many dwelling places. If there were not, would I have told you that I am going to prepare a place for you?** Do we believe that we have a place in the eternal embrace of God? Jesus reminds us that he will never abandon us and we will be with him always. Jesus also says: **I am the way and the truth and the life.** Do our lives reflect our belief in this statement? There is much comfort and strength we can find in the Gospel passage for today. May we always strive to follow the way of Christ and trust in the power of our faith.

As we enter the month of May, a month dedicated to our Blessed Mother, we will pray the **Rosary** 30 minutes before each weekend Mass. Please come to Mass a little early and join us in prayer. This weekend we will also be doing a **May Crowning** of our May statue at each of the Masses. Some of the children who received their First Communion in the past weeks along with their families will be placing the crown of flowers on the statue. Also, we will have our outdoor **Fatima Rosary** in honor of our Blessed Mother on Saturday, May 16, at 11am. This will take place in our Mary Garden on the north side of church. All are welcome to participate.

This weekend, May 3-4, is one of our designated monthly collections for the **FUTURE PROJECTS FUND**. As we approach the summer months, this is the time of year when we plan for various projects around our campus. We are grateful to those who regularly contribute to the Fund as it builds up over the year and provides some of the needed funding for these projects. 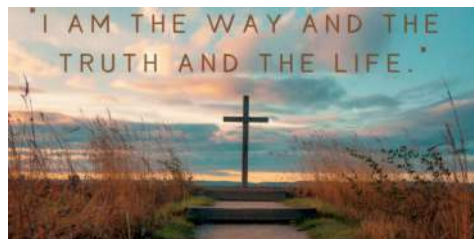

Jesús es el Camino; el Cielo es nuestra recompensa

Queridos amigos: hoy celebramos el quinto Domingo de Pascua. Nuestras lecturas provienen de Hechos 6:1-7; 1 Pedro 2:4-9; y el Evangelio es según San Juan 14:1-12.

Estas Escrituras nos afirman que: somos una raza elegida, un sacerdocio real, llamados a depositar nuestra fe y confianza en el Espíritu de Jesús, quien guía a la comunidad de fe. Así, somos invitados a confiar en Jesús y a confiar en Dios.

Este pasaje del Evangelio recibe el nombre de "discurso de despedida." Jesús, durante la Última Cena con sus discípulos, anunció su inminente partida. Esto entristeció a los discípulos. Jesús abordó esta tristeza de los discípulos diciendo: "No se turbe vuestro corazón. Creéis en Dios; creen también en mí." Jesús asegura a los discípulos que no los abandona; más bien, regresa al Padre para prepararles un lugar en la "casa de su Padre", y que ellos estarán con Él y habitarán con Él eternamente en esa casa.

El Cielo es la casa de Dios, con muchas moradas. Es la casa donde a Dios nunca se le acaba el espacio para nosotros. Es nuestro destino final. Un lugar de relación íntima con Dios. Es un lugar de felicidad perpetua. San Josemaría, en sus reflexiones sobre el Cielo, dijo: "El Cielo es la meta

tangible y el destino final de la existencia humana en nuestro camino en la tierra. Jesús ha ido por delante de nosotros y nos espera allí, en compañía de Nuestra Señora y de San José..." (Los Amigos de Jesús, no. 220).

Por lo tanto, mis queridos, en medio de las alegrías y las luchas que atravesamos en este mundo, nunca dejes de pensar en el Cielo, porque el Cielo es la recompensa que Jesús ganó para nosotros mediante su Muerte en la cruz y su Resurrección de entre los muertos.

Nuestro anhelo del Cielo nos llama a someternos a la supremacía de Cristo, porque a través de Él, Dios se ha revelado al mundo y ha hecho de Jesucristo el único camino hacia Él: "Yo soy el Camino, la Verdad y la Vida... os llevaré conmigo." Esforcémonos, pues, amigos, por conocer y amar a Jesús. Que nuestra labor más importante sea cultivar una unión íntima con Jesucristo, quien nos ha hecho visible al Dios invisible a través de todas sus obras y palabras. Por medio de Jesús, somos amigos de Dios. Conozcámoslo, amémoslo y hagámonos uno con Él.

Seamos hermanos y amigos eternos en Cristo y en la Santísima Virgen María.
