Thoughts from Fr. Tom

Today's Gospel is the familiar parable of the **Sower and the Seed**. As Jesus explains in the parable, the seed that falls on the path, rocky ground, and among thorns, bears no fruit. **But some seed fell on rich soil, and produced fruit, a hundred or sixty or thirtyfold. Whoever has ears ought to hear.** We are called to be the rich soil that allows the seed of God's Word to take root in our lives and bear much fruit. *How are we cultivating rich soil in our lives so that we can bear the fruit of God's love? Are we taking time to be in God's presence through prayer and reflection? Are we putting our faith into action by the ways we worship and serve? Are we using our faith to stand up against the injustices of our world and be a voice for those who are too often not heard?* Jesus tells us that if we have ears we "ought to hear". Let us take time to truly listen and hear how God is calling us to bear the good fruit of our faith.

Don't forget about our summer **"School Supply Drive"** for Lee's Summit Social Services that begins this week. This drive assists hundreds of children in our area with needed school supplies so they can be ready for the new school year. The list of items needed are in the bulletin and on our website. 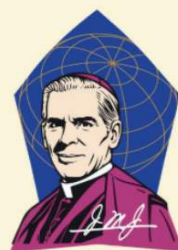

Frequently Asked Questions about Infant Baptism

How do I set up my child's Baptism?

Registered parishioners can visit www.olpls.org/baptism to complete the information form. We ask first-time parents and those who have not had a child baptized in the past 5 years to attend our Baptism Preparation Class. Children are welcome to join us. The classes are offered ten times each year.

What's the best age for Baptism?

Infant Baptism is based on the parents' faith. Children from birth to age six are eligible. Children seven and older are catechized appropriately to their age. We encourage baptism by the age of six months so that your child receives the graces of baptism and support of our community early in life.

When are baptisms scheduled?

Ordinarily, baptisms are scheduled after the 4:30 pm Mass on Saturdays or the noon Mass on Sundays. Occasional exceptions are made as necessary.

Al celebrar este decimoquinto domingo, nuestras lecturas provienen de Isaías 55, 10-11 y Romanos 8, 18-23, y el Evangelio es según san Mateo 13, 1-23. Estas lecturas nos invitan a escuchar la Palabra de Dios con el mayor interés.

Hoy en día, muchas personas buscan formas de conectar con aquello que trasciende lo humano: Dios. Al buscar en Google cuántas personas intentan encontrar una conexión espiritual, descubrí que había más de 83.100.000 millones resultados.

Esto significa que muchas personas buscan a Dios. San Agustín, en su juventud, estaba muy alejado de Dios mientras perseguía placeres mundanos; estos lo dejaban infeliz y frustrado. hombre, el cual no puede ser llenado por ninguna otra cosa que exista, sino solo por Dios, el Creador.”

Queridos amigos, el secreto del crecimiento espiritual reside en oír y escuchar la Palabra de Dios, permitiendo que el corazón se convierta en tierra fértil, capaz de recibir esa Palabra, la cual tiene el potencial de dar muchos frutos.

Nuestros corazones son la tierra donde cae la semilla (la Palabra de Dios). Así como la semilla que cae en buena tierra produce mucho fruto, ocurre lo mismo con la Palabra de Dios cuando cae en un corazón fértil: produce muchos hombres y mujeres santos. Que la tierra de nuestros corazones sea receptiva a la Palabra de Dios.
