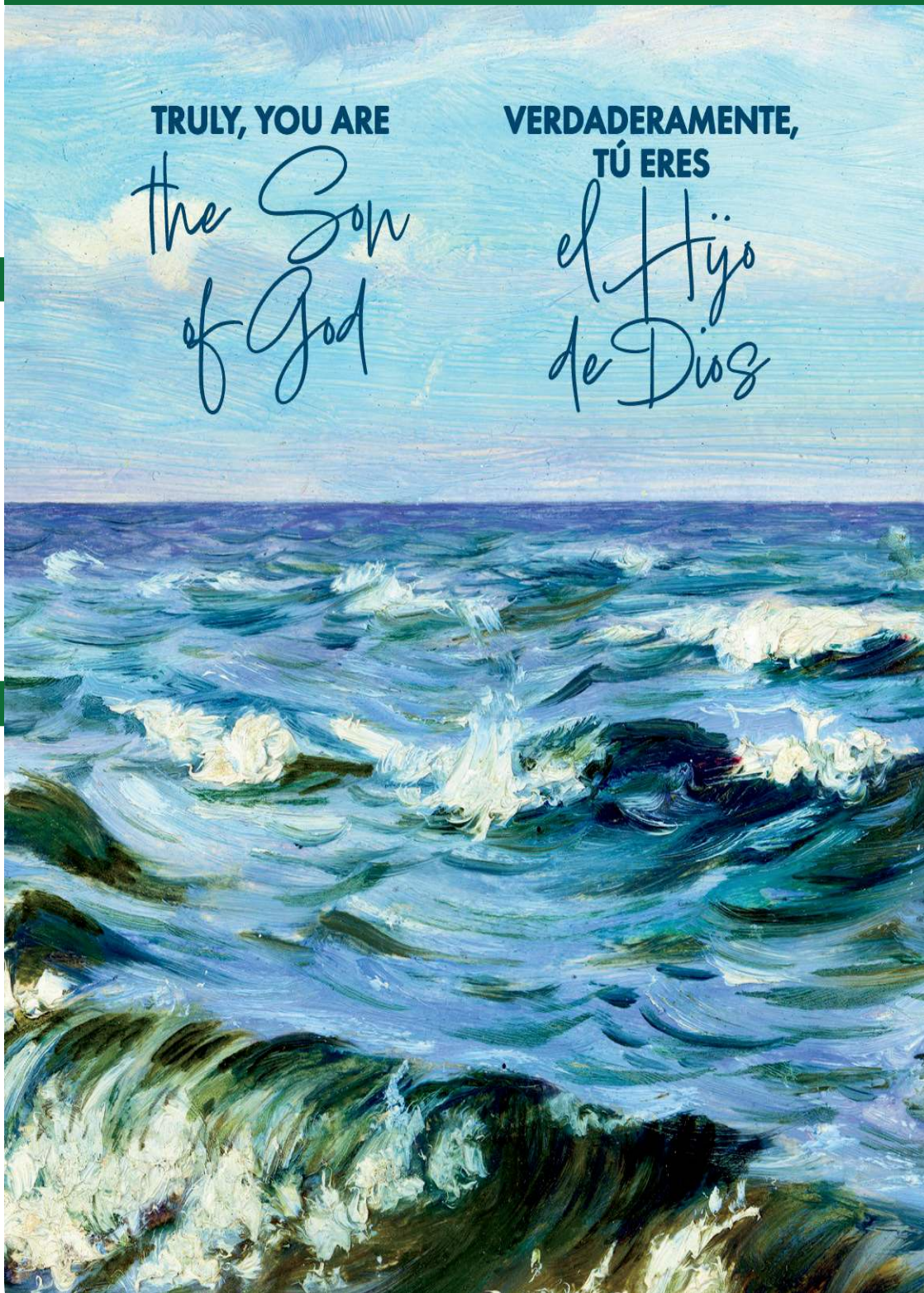

Saint Kateri Tekawitha Lily of the Mohawks

Kateri Tekakwitha was born in 1656 to a Mohawk chief and a Christian Algonquin woman who had been captured in a raid and assimilated into the Mohawk people. She was born in Ossernenon, on the south side of the Mohawk River near present-day Auriesville, New York. The Kanienkehaka or Mohawk people pronounce Kateri's name as Gah-deh-LEE (Kateri) Deh-gah-GWEE-tah (Tekakwitha).

When she was four years old, a smallpox outbreak ravaged her village. Her parents and brother died, and Kateri herself was left with a scarred face and vision damage.

Tekakwitha was adopted by her paternal aunt, whose husband was a prominent figure in the Turtle Clan of the Mohawk nation.

When Tekakwitha was about eighteen, she began instructions in the Catholic faith. On Easter Sunday 1676, she was baptized in Saint Peter's Chapel. On Christmas Day 1677 she made her first communion, and on the Feast of the Annunciation in 1679 she made a vow of perpetual virginity; however, her vow was not formally recognized by a bishop.

Kateri's health failed, and she died on April 17, 1680, at the age of 23 or 24. She is also seen as a bridge between Native American and European cultures. In the centuries since her death, she has had devotees ranging from French priests to Native American mystics to the Canadian Jewish songwriter and author Leonard Cohen. She is associated with



exiles, orphans, and people ridiculed for their beliefs. She is also patroness of Indigenous people, patroness of ecology and ecologists, and Protectress of Canada.

Kateri was declared Venerable by Pope Pius XII on January 3, 1943; beatified by Pope Saint John Paul II on June 22, 1980; and canonized

by Pope Benedict XVI on October 21, 2012. A National Shrine was established to honor Saint Kateri and to continue her legacy of devotion, healing, and intercultural encounter between Native and European Americans.

The Gospel we hear today shares the story of Jesus calming the storm and walking on the water. Ante las Tempestades, Miremos a Jesús

Celebrando el decimonoveno domingo del tiempo ordinario, las lecturas provienen de 1 Reyes 19, 9. 11-13 y Romanos 9, 1-5; el Evangelio es según san Mateo 14, 22-33. Estas lecturas destacan la importancia de la fe en Dios durante las tormentas de la vida.

El profeta Elías atravesaba una tormenta. Había huido del rey Ahaz y de su esposa Jezabel, quienes habían jurado matarlo. Mientras se escondía en una cueva, clamó a Dios para que lo salvara. Elías encontró a Dios en una brisa suave; su fe en el Dios salvador se vio fortalecido. En el Evangelio, Jesús caminó sobre las aguas junto a Pedro, quien comenzó a hundirse debido a la duda y a la falta de fe. Cuando Pedro gritó pidiendo auxilio, Jesús le tendió la mano y lo salvó. Al igual que nosotros y los discípulos en general, Pedro depositó más fe en el viento que soplaba que en el Señor que estaba justo delante de él.

En nuestra vida cotidiana, atravesamos muchas tormentas. Luchamos contra numerosas pruebas y tribulaciones. Hay momentos en que la vida se convierte en una lucha desesperada: miedo a los desconocidos, miedo a lo incierto, tentaciones que parecen incontrolables, penas y decisiones difíciles.

Pero hay algo fundamental: Jesús nos enseña que, en esos momentos de lucha, no debemos sentirnos solos. Así como caminó sobre aguas agitadas hacia sus discípulos, les tendió la mano y los salvó, Jesús acude a cualquier persona en medio de las tormentas de la vida, con las manos extendidas para salvarlas y, con voz pacífica, serena y clara, le dice: **“¡Ánimo! No temas.”** Sí, Jesús calma nuestros corazones atemorizados mediante su presencia silenciosa. Es una enseñanza clásica sobre la fe y el mantener la mirada fija en Él, en lugar de en las dificultades que se nos presentan a diario.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas: sea cual sea la tormenta que enfrentemos en la vida, Jesús nos invita a aferrarnos siempre a Él. Cuando Jesús está en nuestra barca, el viento merma; es decir, allí donde está Jesucristo, hasta la tormenta más violenta se calma. Que tanto ustedes como yo, tengamos presente a Jesús cuando afrontemos cualquier tormenta de la vida. Él calma nuestras tormentas.

Seamos amigos y hermanos eternos en Cristo y en la Santísima Virgen María. **¡Feliz Domingo**
