


Welcome to the 2023-2024 School year!

TUITION REMINDER: Please make sure to keep up with tuition payment schedules. If you signed up to pay tuition over 12 months, payments should have begun in June. If you signed up to pay over 10 months, please begin paying in August. If you have misplaced your tuition contract and need to find out your monthly payment amount, or have any questions about your tuition, please call the office.

- CASH OR CHECK PAYMENTS can be placed in the collection basket during Mass, delivered to the parish office or the school office, or simply sent into school with your child. Payments brought to school by children are collected by teachers

#### **Student Drop-off and Pick-up**

Morning Drop-Off takes place in the North Parking lot, beginning at 7:30 a.m., and continuing until 7:55 a.m. Adult staff members are always in the parking lot to assist your child(ren) from 7:30 – 8:00 a.m. Morning announcements begin at 7:55 a.m. and students entering the building after announcements are considered tardy.

**Afternoon Pick-Up** takes place in the gymnasium, beginning at 3:05 p.m. Students in grades K - 8 will be lined up with their classrooms by grade. You must walk up to your child's group to pick him/her up. Students grades 6-8 with no younger siblings will be taken to the Presbyterian lot by teachers and released to parents at that location.

\*In the case of inclement weather, you will be notified to pick up your child(ren) in the school gym, in a similar manner as described above. *ALL students, (K - 8), must be dismissed individually from the gym.* Students are not allowed to exit the building unattended.

Dear Current and Future Choristers,

We are in the midst of creating the 2023-2024 Choristers roster for students in grades 3-8, and I am already looking forward to another great year of music, fun, and learning!

For those of you who are unfamiliar, Choristers is the liturgical children's choir at Presentation School. Our main task is to provide music at Wednesday all school masses throughout the school year.

Rehearsals for Choristers are divided into two sections, dependent upon grade level:

-Middle School Choristers will rehearse on Tuesday and Wednesday mornings from 7:15am – 7:45am. - Elementary School Choristers will rehearse on Tuesday afternoons from 3:15pm – 4:30pm.

Both Choristers groups will combine and lead the music at all-school masses each Wednesday.

In addition to weekly school masses, Choristers will have the opportunity to provide music for special liturgies: occasional weekend masses, Christmas Eve Mass, and First Communion Masses.

**SCRIP UPDATE:** Scrip is a PTO fundraiser. We do not sell candy bars, cookie dough, or wrapping paper. This is a fundraiser where you buy gift cards - at face value - for items you are already purchasing and a percentage of the total gift card is returned as a rebate. The PTO receives the first \$50 of rebates and then all rebates after that are split 50-50 with half going to the PTO, the other half

being applied to your child's tuition the following school year.

PTO uses this money to help take care of our teachers, put on events for your children and family, and purchase much needed supplies.

Does it take a little planning? YES! But it is so worth it! If used consistently, rebates REALLY do add up fast! Get Grandma and Grandpa involved. They always love to help the grandkids!

How do you get started? Set up your Family Account. Go to shopwithscrip.com and click on "Create Account." Fill in the required information and click "I Accept." Provide the answers to two security questions from the list. Finally, link your account to our school by entering our school code: E2LF4D9C8846.

With each business, you will be given the option to purchase an Ecard or a physical card (sometimes both). If you choose a physical card, many are kept in stock, but those that have to be ordered, usually arrive within the week.

You can pay by check, credit card, or checking account. There is also a new app that makes ordering scrip super easy. 


