

A message from Father Tom...

I pray your **Lenten journey** is going well. We are just completing the second full week of this holy season, so there is still plenty of time to focus on our faith journey as we seek to grow in our relationship with Christ.

The 40 days of Lent give us an opportunity to reflect on our lives and the changes we need to make in preparation for Easter. Our school students will have daily reminders of Lent through prayer, visual displays, and special opportunities for devotions like Adoration and Stations of the Cross, as well as the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

But I also encourage you to find ways to focus on the Lenten journey as a family at home. The disciplines of Lent – *prayer*, *fasting*, *and almsgiving* – can be daily reminders of how we are called to deepen our relationship with God and one another. The **Lenten Blessing Box** project can be a visual reminder of how we can make sacrifices for the good of others. The money collected from the Blessing Box project will go to support our scholarship students in our sister community in El Salvador.

You can also take advantage of the various **Lenten offerings** here at Presentation. You can make your Lent meaningful by joining us for our *daily and weekend Masses*, *Friday Stations of the Cross*, *Friday Fish Fries*, *Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, and the Sacrament of Reconciliation, and by deepening your prayer life with our Parish Lenten Daily prayer booklet, Best Lent Ever daily emails and all the opportunities for prayer and faith enrichment*. And Lent is a great time to get back in the practice of regularly attending Mass as a family if you have fallen out of the habit.

In the coming weeks, there will be lots of excitement about spring break and Easter. But take time as a family to really make Lent meaningful by taking advantage of all the beautiful traditions and devotions the season offers. And especially, let us keep one another in prayer.

End of Quarter Reminders

The end of the 3rd Quarter is quickly approaching, on Thursday, March 7. As a reminder, all accounts must be current, as indicated below, in order for your child's report card to be released.

- Tuition payments: Please remember that tuition payments must be paid in full through February in order for your child(ren)'s report cards to be released. You may go online at www.sycamore.com to check your tuition balance and to make your tuition payments. Checks or cash may be dropped off at the school or parish offices. If you have any questions, please contact the parish Finance Office at 816.251.1100.
- Lunch Accounts must be current without a negative balance through March 7. Online payments should be made directly into your Sycamore account. If questions, please contact Mrs. Wade, at mwade@olpls.org.
- ACED Accounts must have February monthly charges paid. Online payments should be made directly into your Sycamore account. If questions, please contact Mrs. Henry, ahenry@olpls.org.



If your family will be attending Presentation School for the 2024-25 school year, we ask that you complete the registration process as outlined in the parent email sent February 6. As you may be aware, OLP has a waiting list for many grades and new families are hoping to enroll their students as of March 1. Please complete enrollment documents or call the office to ensure that your student(s)' spot is not offered to an incoming student.

We ask ACED parents to please plan to pick your students up via the south Church entrance. An ACED employee will be stationed there to have you sign your child out.
