HOW TO APPLY FOR A MOSCHOLARS SCHOLARSHIP

Go to BrightFuturesFund.org. Click on MOScholars Program then MOScholars Scholarships. Click the button for your diocese. Fill out the pre-qualification form to see if you qualify to move on to the formal application.

Qualifying Paths

To qualify, your student must meet one or more of the state designated criteria. Scholarships are verified by F. A.C.T. S, granted in order according to state rules based on available funding.

- Siblings of current MOScholars recipients
- Students with an approved IEP 'individualized education plan' developed under federal Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) or an individual service plan (ISP) that is developed in cooperation with a local education agency under IDEA, specifically those provisions pertaining to parentally placed private school children found in 20 U.S. Code 1412 (a) (10) and 34 CFR 300(b).*
- Attended a public school as a full time student for at least one semester during the previous twelve (12) months Are eligible to begin kindergarten or first grade
- Must meet MOScholars income eligibility guidelines
- Please refer to BrightFuturesFund.org or the MO State Treasurer's website for current eligibility requirements.






