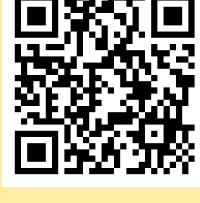

CHRISTMAS FAIR

The Christmas Fair is right around the corner! On **Monday, December 15**, the PTO will sponsor this annual event where each child will have the opportunity to select gifts for their immediate family members (those who live in their home/no more than 4 gifts). There will be a flat fee of \$5 for up to four gifts. No change will be provided. There will be items for babies, young children, teens and adults. The children love shopping for their families and we need your help to make this day a success! Here's how you can help:

- Donate your gently used treasures (jewelry, toys, knick-knacks, games with all of their pieces, home décor, men's items, etc.) We are ALWAYS in need of items for men especially!
- We cannot accept clothing, hats, large items (children need to be able to carry these gifts home), sharp objects, R-rated DVDs, small appliances or items that have already been opened (perfume, paint, lotion).
- A good rule of thumb: When donating, ask yourself "Would I like to receive this as a gift?"
- Donate your time! Look for a SignUp Genius coming soon for volunteer opportunities on **Sunday, December 14** (set up) and Monday, December 15 (helping kids shop, checking out and clean up).

You may drop items off at the front office in the Christmas Fair bin. We will be accepting items until **Wednesday, December 10**.
