All volunteers are required to complete Virtus Training (virtusonline.org) and (<https://protectmokies.com/>). Both are available online and when completed certificates need to be emailed to or dropped off at the school office. These are both diocesan requirements for volunteers in any school.



READY TO APPLY FOR THE 2026-2027 SCHOOL YEAR?

It's time! Take the next step and apply to be a student at St. Michael the Archangel!

Steps to apply:

- Complete an application. Submit by December 15 to be considered for early admittance. smacatholic.org/applynow
- Register and take the High School Placement Test (HSPT) on Saturday, December 6 or Saturday, January 10. Applications will not be considered without results from the HSPT.

Once the steps above are complete, St. Michael administrators will review the information in January and decision letters will be sent in late January during Catholic Schools Week.

Worried about tuition costs? We never want finances to be the reason families don't attend St. Michael. There is assistance available! Complete an application for financial assistance by December 31.
