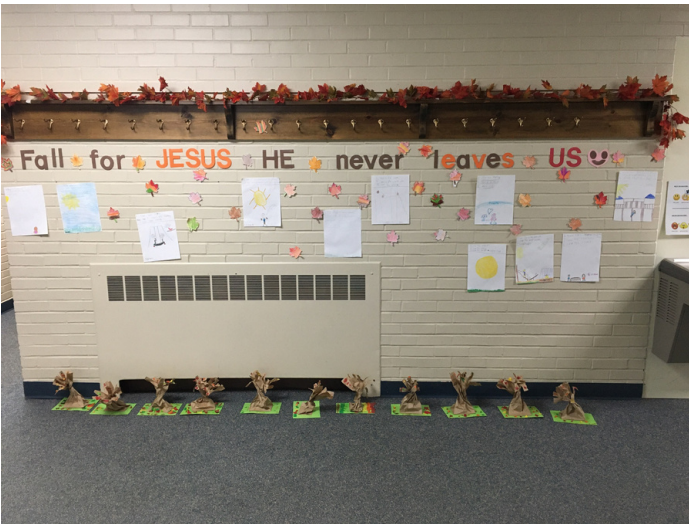
Topics Include

**Fulfilling one's just duties; accepting the consequences of one's words and actions, intentional and unintentional.**

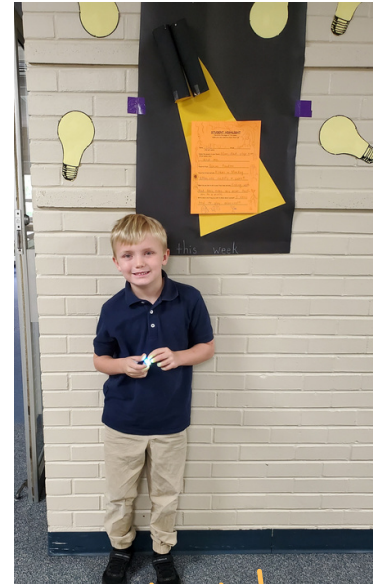
**LOOKS LIKE:**
