WINDTHORST FLU AND IMMUNIZATION CLINIC – The Department of State Health Services will be conducting a Flu Clinic in Windthorst at St. Mary's Parish Hall on **Thursday, October 2, 2014** from 9:30 – 11:30 and 1:00 – 4:00.

Adult and children's flu vaccines will be offered. Vaccines will also be available for kindergarten, seventh grade and college entry. All infant immunizations will also be offered.

The Texas Department of State Health Services provides vaccines for those on Medicaid, no insurance, American Indian, Native Alaskan, and the under-insured. CHIP and private insurance are not accepted at this clinic. If your private insurance covers vaccines, you will be referred to your doctor. Parent or guardians must accompany a minor. VFC vaccines are provided for \$10.00 per visit, with a maximum of \$20.00 per household. Adult vaccines are \$20.00 per visit for the adult with no insurance.

Adults and Children who **do not** meet the State's requirements will also be able to receive their flu vaccine that day from United Pharmacy. Ricky Schroeder will be helping to provide flu shots for the people who do not qualify with the health department. For more information regarding the clinic, please call 940-574-2159.
