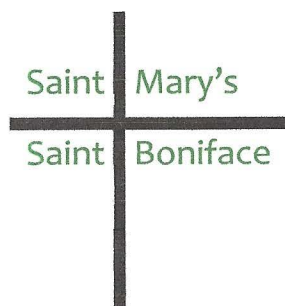

Dear Parishioners:

Church will be opened this weekend for people to attend Mass. As we slowly return to the public celebration of Mass, we ask for your help and cooperation in keeping everyone safe and from spreading the COVID-19 virus. Even though Archer County has been very fortunate and there are no known cases of the virus we will have some guidelines to follow:

1. **Mass is NOT an obligation at this time due to the pandemic.** The elderly people and those with any type of health issues are encouraged to stay at home and if possible, to watch the Masses that are being live streamed at St. Boniface and St. Mary's, EWTN or any other Catholic Church services that are on TV. Or you may feel more comfortable sitting in your car and watching the live stream and receiving Holy Communion at the designated time.
2. If you wish to attend Mass in person there will be guidelines, namely everyone **MUST** wear a mask and keep the 6 ft distance rule.
3. I will be having two Masses for the most vulnerable people at this time—those 60 years of age and older—at St. Mary's at 5 PM on Saturday and at St. Boniface at 8 AM Sunday. The 10:30 AM Mass at St. Mary's will be for all those under the age of 60, everyone must wear a mask and keep the 6 ft distancing.
4. Ushers will be playing a big role in this and we ask that you give them much consideration and respect as they are only following the orders handed down from the Bishop through me to them.
5. Pews are roped off, using only every other pew. Only 25% capacity of the churches will be allowed to be used at this time. (in St. Mary's that will be approximately 100 persons and at St. Boniface approximately 35. People will occupy pews—one on each end of the pew, family members (those living in the same household) will be allowed to sit in the same pew, as well as couples. At St. Boniface, Ushers will escort you to the first front pew that is available. And using every other pew. Unused pews will be roped off and we ask that you do not remove the markings.
6. The people will be seated from the front to the back. Ushers will greet you at the door and usher you to the front. Once again wearing a mask and keeping the distance of 6 ft. When we reach the capacity of 100 at St. Mary's and 35 at St. Boniface and the churches are full, you will not be allowed to enter into the church building. You may go to your car and watch the live stream.
7. Father will enter the sanctuary and Mass will begin and proceed as usual. There will be **NO PROCESSION** in or out of Mass. At Communion time, a Deacon Seminarian will be here to assist Father and he will be the one to distribute Holy Communion, inside first and then outside the Church.

8. 5 PM Mass—at Communion time-- we ask the people in their cars to come forward to the area of the glass doors, where a station will be set up, for them to receive Holy Communion.
9. Once again, I want to stress that attending Mass is NOT an obligation at this time due to the pandemic.
10. St. Boniface—8 AM Mass-- at Communion time-- we ask the people in their cars to come forward to the area of the bulletin board, where a station will be set up, for them to receive Holy Communion.
11. At the 10:30 AM Mass at St. Mary's, the parish hall will be open for those desiring not to attend Mass in the church building, or when the church has reached its capacity or in their cars. The Mass will be live streamed and the same guidelines will need to be followed. Once again, I want to stress that Mass is NOT an obligation at this time due to the pandemic.
12. 10:30 AM Mass--AT Communion time, we ask the people in their cars to enter the parish hall to receive Communion, still keeping the 6 ft. distance and wearing a mask.
13. When Mass is ended, people will exit from the back of the church—keeping their distance and if visiting on the parking lot please wear your mask and keep the 6 ft distance.
14. COLLECTION--- Please drop your donation in a designated basket as you enter or exit at the church entrance.
15. At this time there will be little music as there will be NO song books, missalettes and other prayers in the pews of the churches. There will be no distribution of the Precious Blood, no shaking of hands at the Sign of Peace.
16. I ask for your prayers that all these new guidelines will work for everyone. I will continue to remember all of you in my prayers that God will keep you safe and I ask that you remember me in your prayers. God bless you.
17. Bishop Michael Olson is working very closely with Governor Greg Abbott and together are trying to find the best way to keep the Covid-19 from spreading. Thank God that Archer County has been case free and with God's help we will try to keep it safe.
- 18. REMEMBER TO BE ABLE TO ENTER THE CHURCH BUILDINGS ONE MUST BE WEARING A MASK AND TO KEEP A DISTANCE OF 6 FT FROM EACH OTHER. (UNLESS YOU ARE LIVING IN THE SAME HOUSEHOLD)**
19. Confessions—I will start hearing confessions on Saturday, May 2nd at 2 PM. down at the pavilion.
20. Both churches will need to be sanitized after each usage. If you would like to volunteer for this task please call Margaret at the office (423-6687) or home (423-6630) for more details.
- 21. PLEASE REMEMBER THAT THE 5 PM ST. MARY'S AND THE 8 am ST. BONIFACE WILL BE FOR THOSE 60 AND OLDER. A MASK IS REQUIRED.**
22. Bulletins will be available on the tables in entrance of church for you to pick up.
23. The week day Masses will open to the public on Monday, May 4, 2020.
