Coordinator's Corner ~ Esquina del Coordinador

The scripture today tells us about the joy God feels at the conversion of a repentant sinner. Jesus compares it to the joy of the shepherd who finds the lost sheep, and to the joy of a father who recovers a wayward child.

It is joy for God, who restores that which was lost, and it is joy for the repentant sinner, who experiences being loved and accepted despite his unworthiness. He also experiences the internal strength to become a different person, guided by love to do good.

The beginning of salvation for the prodigal son is when, acknowledging his own sin, he accepts the truth and remembers the goodness of his father. The result is deep joy which changes the situation. The heart of the father is full of joy at recovering the lost son. The heart of the son is full of grateful joy and of unconditional love.

We are all called to this banquet of reconciliation, forgiveness, shared peace, and restoration of what was lost. *This process of reconciliation and reconstruction has two different directions:* on the one hand is the necessary attitude of the offender to acknowledge his fault, ask for forgiveness, be determined to change and offer his good will to start a different behavior; while on the other hand, needing the generous and loving will to forgive by the person who has been hurt.

The home should be a place of peace and affection, where one finds refuge after the struggles of work and society in general. Unfortunately, the home peace is often disturbed by discord, jealousy, and offenses more or less serious. Even Pope Francis describes how "plates fly" in marital discord in his encyclical *Amoris Laetitia (The Joy of Love)*.

Often in today's world those situations are solved by divorce or family breakdown. It would be much better if, when we realize that a relationship or the harmony of the home is deteriorating, we all would honestly seek in our hearts the origin of the evil; we would accept our own responsibility, and ask for, receive, and offer forgiveness with generosity. The result of this would be a newly found love, a unity established on more solid grounds, and the joy to find again what seemed to be lost or about to be lost. And then, there would be a determination to work so that new discord does not take place.

At what moments of this week have I needed to forgive or to be forgiven? What has been my experience when I have asked for forgiveness? What family conflicts do we need to face and reconcile?

Las escrituras de hoy nos hablan sobre el gozo que Dios siente por la conversión de un pecador arrepentido. Jesús lo compara con la alegría del pastor que encuentra la oveja perdida, y con la alegría de un padre que recupera un hijo descarriado.

Es alegría para Dios, quien restaura lo que se perdió, y es alegría para el pecador arrepentido, que experimenta ser amado y aceptado a pesar de su indignidad. También experimenta la fuerza interna para convertirse en una persona diferente, guiado por el amor para hacer el bien.

El comienzo de la salvación para el hijo pródigo es cuando, reconociendo su propio pecado, acepta la verdad y recuerda la bondad de su padre. El resultado es una alegría profunda que cambia la situación. El corazón del padre está lleno de alegría al recuperar al hijo perdido. El corazón del hijo está lleno de alegría agradecida y de amor incondicional.

Todos estamos llamados a este banquete de reconciliación, perdón, paz compartida y restauración de lo que se perdió. *Este proceso de reconciliación y reconstrucción tiene dos direcciones diferentes:* por un lado, es la actitud necesaria del delincuente para reconocer su culpa, pedir perdón, estar decidido a cambiar y ofrecer su buena voluntad para comenzar un comportamiento diferente; mientras que, por otro lado, necesita la voluntad generosa y amorosa de perdonar por la persona que ha sido lastimada.

El hogar debe ser un lugar de paz y afecto, donde uno encuentre refugio después de las luchas del trabajo y la sociedad en general. Desafortunadamente, la paz en el hogar a menudo se ve perturbada por la discordia, los celos y las ofensas más o menos graves. Incluso el Papa Francisco describe cómo "los platos vuelan" en discordia marital en su encíclica *Amoris Laetitia (La Alegría del Amor)*.

A menudo en el mundo de hoy esas situaciones se resuelven por el divorcio o la ruptura de la familia. Sería mucho mejor si, cuando nos damos cuenta de que una relación o la armonía del hogar se está deteriorando, todos buscaríamos honestamente en nuestros corazones el origen del mal; aceptaríamos nuestra propia responsabilidad y pediríamos, recibiríamos y ofreceríamos perdón con generosidad. El resultado de esto sería un amor recién encontrado, una unidad establecida sobre bases más sólidas, y la alegría de encontrar de nuevo lo que parecía estar perdido o a punto de perderse. Y luego, habría una determinación de trabajar para que no se produzca una nueva discordia.

¿En qué momentos de esta semana he necesitado perdonar o ser perdonado? ¿Cuál ha sido mi experiencia cuando he pedido perdón? ¿Qué conflictos familiares necesitamos enfrentar y reconciliar?

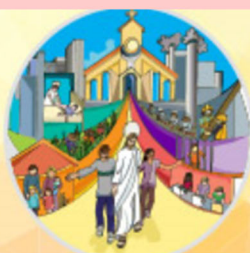

Do you need a “gratitude refill”?

A while back, my husband complained about Church A LOT. He was tired of priests admonishing parishioners during the homily; frustrated that there wasn't a daily mass early enough for his commute; angry when asked to donate to second collections; and he stopped even *trying* to pray. Scott desired closeness with Christ, but Catholicism appeared to be full of barriers and demands. Then Scott changed his view—he chose to focus on his blessings and just thank God for his day before bed... even the stuff that he didn't like, agree with, or that was difficult. It wasn't easy, but guess what? By trying a new approach centered in gratitude, Scott discovered that God HAD remained with him when he was disgruntled — and, *that God still loved him!*

Gratitude refills our tanks when we feel like we are running on empty. At times, life has a way of draining our energy; and if we are not careful, we can come to believe the LIE that God has abandoned us. Scripture reminds us that this has long been a human issue that God understands... He forgave the unfaithful Israelites who worshipped a golden calf, didn't He? ...The father whose son couldn't wait for him to die before getting his inheritance still kept a lookout for that Prodigal Son's return; and upon that return, the father embraced the son with mercy and joy.

St. Paul, although imprisoned in chains, expresses this belief so well, *“I was once a blasphemer and a persecutor and arrogant, but I have been mercifully treated... Indeed the grace of our Lord has been abundant, along with the faith and love that are in Christ Jesus.”* **St. Paul is well aware of the sins he has committed. But this does not hold him back from ministry. Rather, it makes him all the more grateful to be God's steward.** How encouraging to know that this is true for us, as well! Our past sins, and even our present struggles, do not disqualify us from becoming God's grateful stewards. In fact, *the more we have been forgiven and live with the awareness of our continuing need for forgiveness*, the deeper our gratitude to God, and thus the more fuel we have in our tanks to live the stewardship way of life.

It is tempting to live like a worldly shepherd who would not leave the ninety-nine to look for the one. It simply does not make sense to spend the time and energy searching for one when there are so many others to tend to. But God's logic — God's mercy — defies human logic. And, we see this mercy in how the Good Shepherd carries the lost sheep upon his own shoulders — not begrudgingly but with great joy. Imagine that sheep as the Israelites, the unchained Paul, the Prodigal Son, yourself or your child. This God, who created the heavens and the earth, calls each one of us by name and carries us with joy upon His shoulders!

What gratitude we owe to such a personal, passionate, loving God! Just think — even our sins, once forgiven, become a source of fuel for our stewardship way of life as we reflect with deep gratitude on the powerful mercy of our Savior.

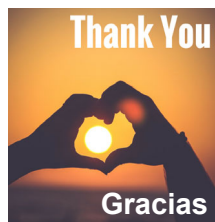
So, when you feel negatively about God, the Church, the Mass, or your spiritual life — and we all do at times — try refilling your tank with gratitude. If you have been allowing life to hold you back from sharing your Time, Talent, or Treasure, try naming and thanking God for daily blessings as you prepare for bed. Jesus wants to know us deeply and for us to get to know Him so that we become His holy disciples. This is not a burden; it is a *privilege to enjoy*.

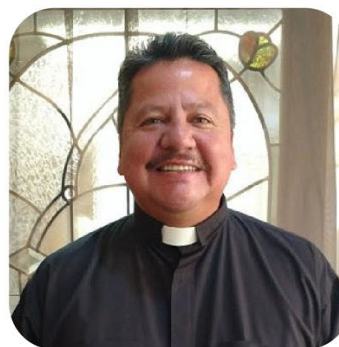

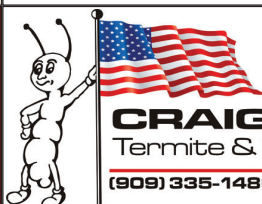
