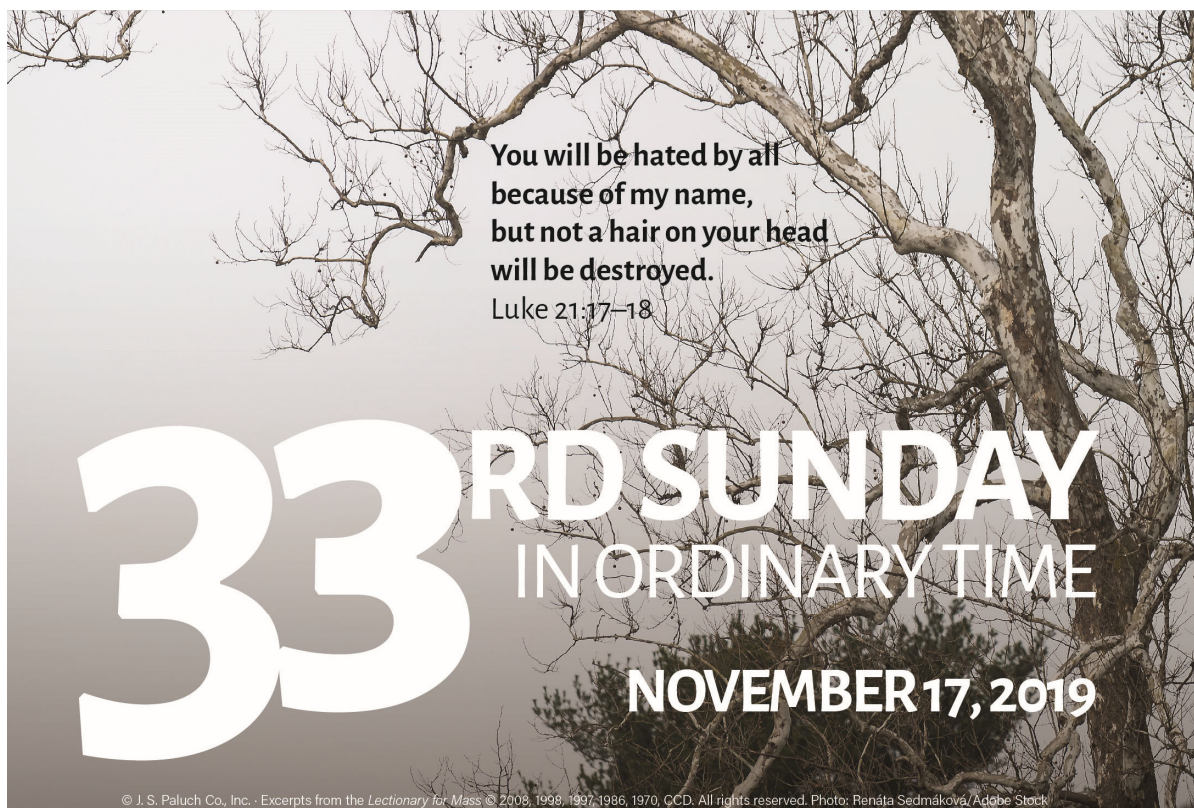

Coordinator's Corner ... Esquina del Coordinador

"Days will come when there will not be left one stone upon another." Today's Gospel speaks of the coming of the end. There will be various types of crisis that precede it, cosmic, global, local and personal. The Lord tells us that such crises will be opportunities for Christian Witness. **When things seem darkest, the Christian can shine like a light in the darkness.** A person's faith will sustain him at such times. Strength in adversity comes when one has taken the time to build a strong relationship with God and a trust in the Spirit's presence. This is not a one-day preparation but one that builds through a life of faith. We are invited to have confidence in the words of the Gospel: *"I myself will give you wisdom in speaking that all your adversaries will be powerless to resist or refute... by your perseverance you will secure your lives."*

One time-tested method of strength in the midst of chaos and crisis is developing an identification with Jesus in His suffering and death. Since the 4th century, the Church has revered the Stations of the Cross as a way to do this. This devotion first arose in Jerusalem as pilgrims retraced on the streets of the Holy City the footsteps of Jesus from His trial before Pilate to His death on Calvary. This devotional practice of walking Jesus' journey has proven to be a source of strong reflection and prayer for Catholics down through the centuries.

El Evangelio de hoy habla de la venida del fin. Habrá diversas clases de crisis que precedan el final, crisis cósmica, global, local y personal. Estas crisis, dice el Señor, serán oportunidades para los testigos cristianos. **Cuando las cosas parezcan muy oscuras, los cristianos pueden brillar como una luz en la oscuridad.** La fe los sostendrá a través de estos tiempos. La fortaleza ante la adversidad se logra cuando uno invierte tiempo en construir una relación sólida con Dios y en fortalecer la confianza en la presencia del Espíritu. Esto se construye a lo largo de una vida de fe, no se consigue en un día. Se nos invita a que confiemos en las palabras del Evangelio:

"Yo mismo les daré una elocuencia y una sabiduría que ninguno de sus adversarios podrá resistir ni contradecir... y por su perseverancia, salvarán sus vidas".

Un método de fortaleza que ha demostrado ser efectivo a través del tiempo en medio de crisis ha sido identificarse con Jesús en Su sufrimiento y muerte. A partir del siglo IV, la iglesia ha venerado el vía crucis como una forma de hacer esto. Esta devoción primero surgió en Jerusalén cuando en las calles de la ciudad santa los peregrinos seguían los pasos que Jesús había tomado desde Su juicio ante Pilato hasta Su muerte en el Calvario. Esta práctica devocional de caminar por el camino de Jesús ha demostrado ser una fuerte fuente de reflexión y oración para los católicos a través de los siglos.

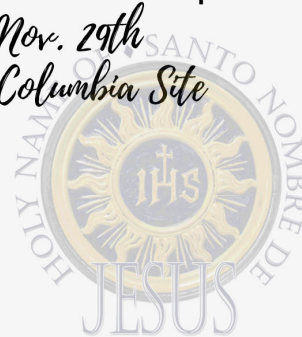

Ice cream for dinner!

When I was little, my mother would allow us to select the menu for dinner on our birthday. I chose hot dogs and mac-n-cheese; a few weeks later, my younger brother, Matthew, chose steak and baked potatoes. When our baby brother, James, insisted on ice cream for dinner, Matt and I looked at each other and exclaimed, "Why didn't I think of that!"

So many times in life, we rely on what we already know to shape our needs and desires... like using the same cleaning products our mothers used, or, like selecting our favorite foods for dinner. Material things that we touch, smell, taste, see, hear; musical beats, singers, colors, flora and fauna... we assign them values largely based on our experiences. But today, Jesus tells the crowd, *"All that you see here — the days will come when there will not be left a stone upon another stone that will not be thrown down."* Oh, goody!

Jesus understands that we may want shiny baubles to wear or ice cream for dinner. He enjoyed the good things life offers (wedding at Cana). Jesus knows our heavenly Father and the eternal world intimately. But, He understands how difficult it can be for us to grasp the unseen, eternal reality that the Father has promised us; and that's why He continually refocuses to look beyond ourselves and our world. We even express this about the gift we receive of His Real Presence when singing the Communion hymn, *"Look beyond the bread you eat; see your Savior and your Lord."*

Most of the time, our tangible world distracts us from what we know: We belong to another world called Heaven.

Recently, I came across a refreshing worldly reminder of this reality on a television show — really! On Sept 25th, Stephen Colbert interviewed actress Patricia Heaton on *The Late Show*, and they spent almost the entire time talking about their Catholic faith! Patricia Heaton, who portrayed Ray's wife on *Everybody Loves Raymond*, shared about her faith journey through years of acting career struggles:



"I got really frustrated because like I literally came out of the womb going 'look at me, look at me, look at me,' you know? And I had nothing to do with it; it's the way I was made. And then I was here for nine years in New York. I couldn't get arrested... I couldn't make anything happen. And I was so angry at God. I was like, 'You put this in me and you have shut every door. What is going on?'

[After] nine years, I got an opportunity to go to LA and the first month I was there I went to an orphanage in Mexico with a Church and we like laid down a lawn and helped the kids. And when I came back I had this huge sense of peace that I'd never had before. **I realized that I had been making the acting career the center of my life. And you know as a Catholic, there's only one thing that can be the center of your life, and that's your faith.** I wasn't doing that. And I think God was withholding everything until... He made sure that He was the center of my life and not the career. *Because look, the career comes and goes. You can't rely on those things because they don't last. And you have to know that the purpose of your life is glorifying God with your life, not glorifying yourself with your career.'*"

Patricia Heaton honed her craft, auditioning thousands of times over those nine long years. She stayed the course, but lacked the proper vision. God gave her a glimpse of eternity after she shared her Time and Talent for Him. When we dedicate our Time, our Talent, and our Treasure to glorifying God FIRST, we receive graces that can weather the storms of life. Focus on glorifying God and stay the course, good stewards. Remember, you have been made for greater things: Heaven.

Catechesis of the Good Shepherd**

The Catechesis of the Good Shepherd is the result of a long period of careful observation of children by Sofia Cavalletti and her Montessori collaborator, Gianna Gobbi, in Rome. It began quite by accident, without warning or planning, the way God so often comes into our lives. In 1954 Sofia was a Hebrew and Scripture scholar, comfortable in her role in the academic world, when a mother asked her to give some religious instruction to her son. At first Sofia refused, saying she knew nothing about children. The mother persisted and eventually, Sofia consented. That experience with a 7 year-old changed her whole life. She saw in that child and in numerous other children since, a way of being in the presence of God that is both unique to the child and a gift to the adult who stops long enough to notice.

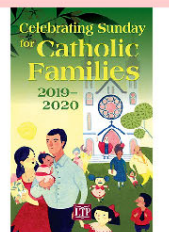

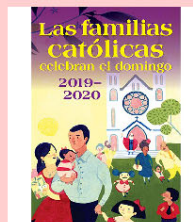


GIFT OF THE GOSPELS:

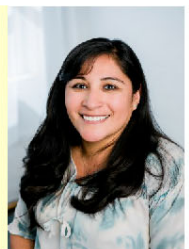

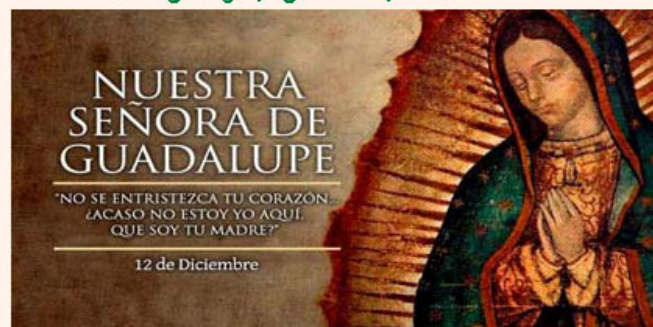

More's decision for principle over politics, conscience over convenience prompted his final words: "*I die the King's good servant, but God's first.*"

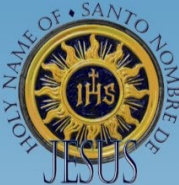

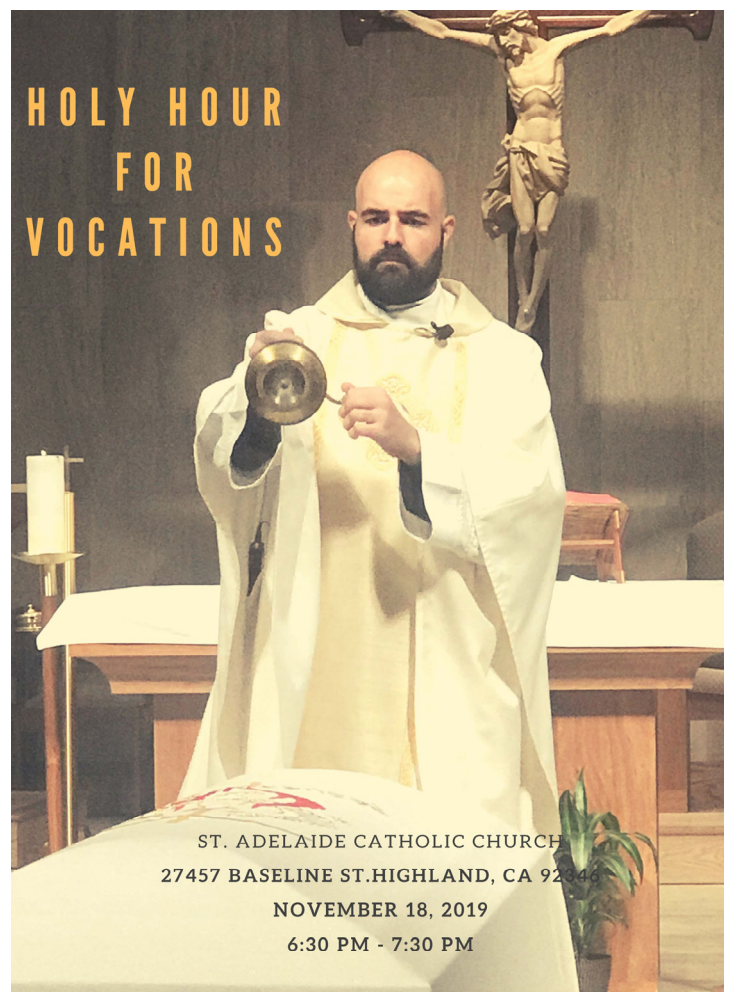
