A Letter from our Pastor

Laetare is a Latin word meaning "rejoice". The 4th Sunday of Lent is known as Laetare Sunday. On this Sunday the Church expresses hope and joy in the midst of our Lenten fasts and penances. The change in color from purple to rose helps to give us a glimpse of the joy that awaits us at Easter, just before we enter into the somber days of the Passion. It is fitting that today we hear the parable of the Prodigal Son. The story of the prodigal son is very familiar. The story begins with an ungrateful, greedy son who asks his father for his inheritance while the father still lives. He then takes and squanders it on "loose living" and ends up destitute, tending to pigs, and unable to even eat what the pigs are eating. In his desperation, he realizes his fault and with hope of forgiveness, dares to return home. When he returns, the unthinkable happens, the father runs to greet him. The father clothes him with the best garments, puts a ring on his finger, shoes on his feet, and kills the fatted calf in celebration of his return. The father rejoices, saying, "My son was lost, but now is found." It is an inspiring story that gives us hope that even our worst sins can be forgiven by the Father who loves us.



Like the prodigal son, how many times have we thought we knew the better path? As baptized Christians, sons and daughters of God, we have been promised a heavenly inheritance of the Kingdom, yet we can turn from God, believing the promised kingdom is here on this earth. It can be easy to seek the enticements of the world. We see in the story that the son realizes he has sought happiness in all the wrong places, and as he sits in the muddy pit with the pigs, he dares to hope that his father might take him back even as a hired servant. How many times have we gone astray and felt unsure whether God would forgive us? We might even stay away from the Lord because we think we are unforgiveable. How difficult that walk home must have been for the son. He probably talked to himself the whole way back, trying to formulate the words to explain to his father what had happened, and why he returned, fearful of his father's response. But as we see in the story, the father does not chastise the son; the father rejoices! He shows his love by running to him, welcoming him and restoring him. Can you imagine the son's disbelief, his relief, and his sorrow at having gone astray? All of his fears must have melted away when he fell into the loving embrace of his father. When we believe and experience God's grace and mercy we cannot help but to rejoice. Rejoice today knowing you are loved by a good God who desires to embrace you and share with you the gift of mercy!

Una Carta de Nuestro Pastor

Laetare es una palabra latina que significa "alégrate". El cuarto domingo de Cuaresma es conocido como el Domingo Laetare. En este domingo, la Iglesia expresa esperanza y alegría en medio de nuestros ayunos y penitencias cuaresmales. El cambio de color de púrpura a rosa nos ayuda a vislumbrar la alegría que nos espera en Pascua, justo antes de entrar en los sombríos días de la Pasión. Es apropiado que hoy escuchemos la parábola del Hijo Pródigo. La historia del hijo pródigo es muy familiar. La historia comienza con un hijo desagradecido y egoísta que pide a su padre la herencia mientras éste aún vive. Luego la toma y la malgasta en "vida vaga" y acaba en la pobreza, cuidando cerdos e incapaz incluso de comer lo que comen los cerdos. En su desesperación, se da cuenta de su falta y, con la esperanza del perdón, se atreve a volver a casa. Cuando regresa, ocurre lo impensable, el padre corre a recibirle. El padre lo viste con las mejores ropas, le pone un anillo en el dedo, zapatos en los pies y mata al ternero cebado para celebrar su regreso. El padre se regocija diciendo: "Mi hijo se había perdido, pero ahora se ha encontrado". Es una historia inspiradora que nos da la esperanza de que incluso nuestros peores pecados pueden ser perdonados por el Padre que nos ama.



Como el hijo pródigo, ¿cuántas veces hemos creído conocer el mejor camino? Como cristianos bautizados, hijos e hijas de Dios, se nos ha prometido una herencia celestial del Reino, y sin embargo podemos apartarnos de Dios, creyendo que el reino prometido está aquí en esta tierra. Puede ser fácil buscar las seducciones del mundo. Vemos en la historia que el hijo se da cuenta de que ha buscado la felicidad en todos los lugares equivocados, y mientras está sentado en el hoyo lleno de lodo con los cerdos, se atreve a esperar que su padre lo acepte de nuevo, incluso como sirviente contratado. ¿Cuántas veces nos hemos desviado del camino y no estamos seguros de que Dios nos perdone? Incluso puede que nos alejemos del Señor porque pensamos que no tenemos perdón. Qué difícil debió de ser para el hijo volver a casa. Probablemente habló consigo mismo durante todo el camino de vuelta, tratando de formular las palabras para explicar a su padre lo que había sucedido, y por qué había vuelto, temeroso de la respuesta de su padre. Pero como vemos en la historia, el padre no castiga al hijo; ¡el padre se alegra! Muestra su amor corriendo hacia él, acogiéndolo y restaurándolo. ¿Te imaginas la sorpresa del hijo, su alivio y su dolor por haberse perdido? Todos sus temores debieron de desaparecer cuando cayó en el abrazo amoroso de su padre. Cuando creemos y experimentamos la gracia y la misericordia de Dios, no podemos sino alegrarnos. Alégrate hoy sabiendo que eres amado por un Dios bueno que desea abrazarte y compartir contigo el don de la misericordia.

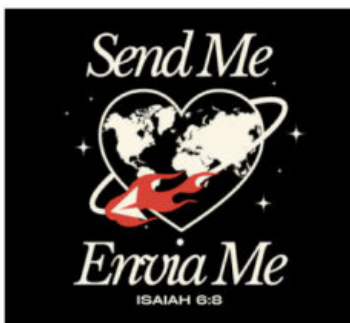

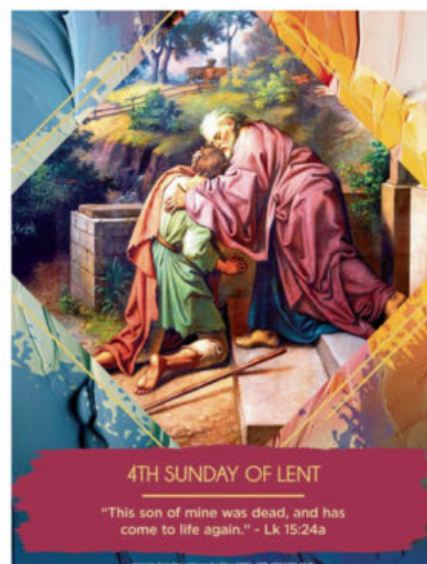

FLORES DE MAYO

Rosary Novena

Flores de Mayo is the Filipino variety of spring flower festivals celebrated in many Asian countries. In the Philippines, the festival is month-long Catholic celebration held in honor of the Virgin Mary in May, the beginning of the rainy season. After a long dry spell, flowers bloom overnight, the landscape bursts with tropical flowers, their fragrance filling the air. Catholic Filipinos celebrate the coming of the rains by giving praise to God and offering devotion to the Blessed Virgin. The celebration features nine days of praying the rosary in honor of the Virgin Mary, donations of flowers from parishioners' gardens which participants offer to the Blessed Mother, children and youth dressed in white (symbolizing the desire to imitate our Blessed Mother's purity of heart), and traditional hymns.

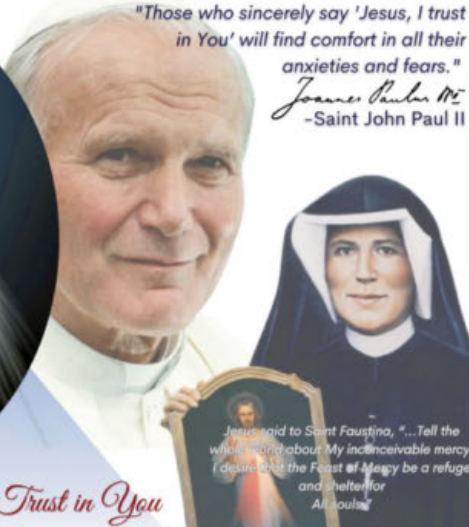

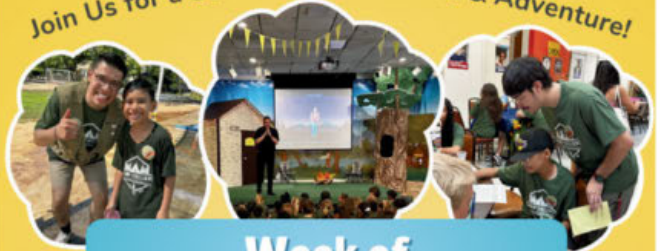

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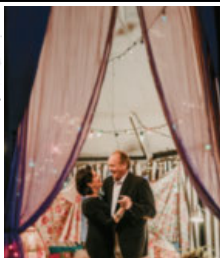
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
