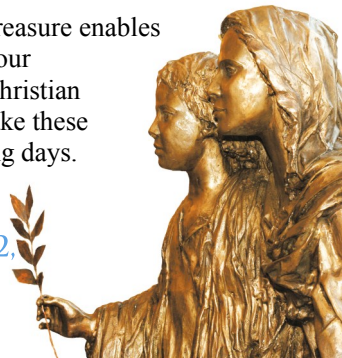

Choose one of the following activities as a way to further reflect on the Sunday readings:

ADULT FAITH FORMATION

Behind-the-Scenes of the Liturgy and Explanatory Mass with Monsignor Jowdy: September 13 and 20

Are you curious about the different vestments, vessels, and gestures that you see each week at Mass? On September 13, Father Al will lead a "behind-the-scenes" tour of the many objects and symbols that contribute to our holy sacrifice at the altar each week. On September 20, he will explain the various movements of the Mass step-by-step. These presentations will take place in the church at 10:15. They are intended for the special benefit of our RCIA inquirers, but they are open to anyone else who may be interested. Parents of children in GIFT classes are especially encouraged to attend.

They must also have attended four preparation sessions this fall (October 3, 17, 24, and 31 – *please note the revision from previous announcements, which incorrectly listed a class during the Fall Break weekend of Oct. 10*) as well as an overnight retreat November 7-8.

REGISTRATION DEADLINE for G.I.F.T. CLASSES—SEPTEMBER 18

Registrations for our parish religion classes will be accepted through September 18. This includes registrations for Confirmation and First Communion preparation. Applications are available at the parish website and in the parish office.

NEW DATES FOR VIRTUS SAFE ENVIRONMENT TRAINING

The VIRTUS Safe Environment training will take place during regular G.I.F.T. classes on Saturday, September 19 and Sunday, September 20. The Middle School training will take place at the normal meeting time on September 30. High School training will be held a date to be announced later this fall.

This abuse-prevention program will be presented to Kindergartners and all new students, as well as students moving into the next level of age-appropriate training (Grades 3, 6, and 9). Parents are welcome to attend. As a parent, you have the right to choose whether your student participates in the program, but you must sign the Parent Notification form whether or not your child participates. This form will be distributed in class over the coming weeks and also emailed to parents.

Children who attend Catholic schools and are enrolled in the G.I.F.T. program for sacramental preparation only will receive VIRTUS Training at their respective schools.

El grupo de jóvenes de High School lo llevará a cabo en una fecha que se anunciará a finales de este otoño.

Este programa de prevención de abuso se les presentará a los niños de Kindergarten y todos los nuevos estudiantes, así como a los estudiantes que pasen al siguiente nivel de entrenamiento apropiado para su edad (Grados 3, 6 y 9).
