## WORKING IN ST. VINCENT'S VINEYARD

An important aspect of helping clients in need is the home visit. Two St. Vincent de Paul case workers, called Vincentians, make an In Home Visit to each client prior to making any recommendations for support.

This extra effort allows the St. Vincent DePaul charitable work to stand out among all local charities, and affords the Case Workers much information they might not receive had they only made a phone call or sent an email.

A recent case with a divorced Mother of 2 children in Decatur is a good example.

The lady works in a restaurant, and barely makes ends meet. She fell behind in her rent, and reached out for support. When our Vincentian Case Workers made the home visit, they could see that there was no furniture whatsoever in the home. Not even mattresses to sleep on. They were sleeping and eating on the floor.

They documented her income and expenses, and learned that she will soon begin training to become a fork lift operator, which will pay more than her up and down restaurant wages.

They recommended we help with the rent in order avoid eviction, and also arranged for 3 mattresses from the St. Vincent de Paul store. Finally, they are working to get more free furniture delivered from the Atlanta Furniture Bank program, for which she qualifies.

Without the home visit, the lack of furniture would never have come up or been noticed.

Thanks to our generous IHM parishioners, St. Vincent de Paul was able to not only help keep her from eviction, but also significantly improved their quality of life by fulfilling a need uncovered with their home visit.

## FATHER ED BOYLE TALK

**Thursday, August 18 & Sunday, August 21**

Jesuit Father Gregory J. Boyle is the founder and executive director of Homeboy Industries in Los Angeles, CA and the author of the 2010 *New York Times* bestseller, *Tattoos on the Heart: The Power of Boundless Compassion*, and he is the subject of a 2012 documentary, *G-Dog*. From 1986-92, he served as pastor of Dolores Mission Church, which was at the time the poorest Catholic parish in LA. Fr. Boyle and parish and community members created an alternative school/daycare program for the gang-involved youth. In 1998 he created Jobs for Future in 2001, which has since become the independent nonprofit organization, Homeboy Industries. Today, Homeboy Industries employs and trains former gang members in a range of social enterprises and provides critical social services to over 10,000 people annually.

Father Boyle will speak at Our Lady of the Assumption in Brookhaven on Thursday, August 18, at 7:00 p.m. and at St. Thomas More in Decatur on Sunday, August 21, at 7:00 p.m. A \$10 donation is requested.

## PARENTS OF CATHOLIC SCHOOL STUDENTS: DON'T FORGET YOUR PARISH STEWARDSHIP COMMITMENTS!

Remember that the Archdiocesan Parish Verification Form describes an "active" Catholic family as: (1) registered in their parish; (2) participating regularly at Mass on Sundays and Holy Days; (3) having a parish Time & Talent commitment on file for the current year and participating in at least one parish ministry; (3) having a parish Treasure commitment on file for the current year and contributing on a regular basis; and (4) pledged and contributing to the Archbishop's Annual Appeal for the current year. Those who do not meet these criteria are "registered but not active" and are not eligible for the "active Catholic" tuition. Please do the right thing now so that your Monsignor Al is able to check "active" when your verification form crosses his desk.

### ENROLLMENT FOR SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION

Students who are eligible to receive the sacraments of Confirmation or First Holy Communion during the 2016-2017 school year may now enroll for sacramental preparation online at <http://www.ihmatlanta.org/sacramental-enrollment>. Hard copies are also available in the parish office.

Please note that this is a separate form intended only for sacramental preparation. Families who wish to enroll students in our regular Faith Formation programs (G.I.F.T., The Edge, and Life Teen) should use the Faith Formation enrollment form (link). Students who will be participating in both programs—for instance, 10th-graders who will attend the weekly Life Teen sessions and the special Confirmation prep sessions—should submit both forms.

The schedule for Confirmation preparation is available below. Details for First Holy Communion 2017 will be available soon.

### CONFIRMATION 2017

Eligible students will receive the Sacrament of Confirmation when Bishop Zarama visits IHM on May 10, 2017. All candidates for Confirmation must be baptized, practicing Catholics, in the 10th grade or higher. They must have received at least two years of religious education immediately prior to being confirmed, either at a Catholic school or through our parish youth ministry program.

In addition to their regular religious education, either through Catholic school or parish youth ministry, Confirmation candidates must also plan to attend the following events. Unless otherwise noted, all events take place on Sunday evenings, 6:15-7:30 pm.

October 16	Preparation Session 1
November 6	Preparation Session 2
December 4	Preparation Session 3
January 22	Preparation Session 4
February 26	Preparation Session 5
March 26	Preparation Session 6
April 29-30	Overnight retreat at Camp Life Teen Hidden Lake Depart IHM at 9:00 a.m. Saturday; return for 5:00 p.m. Mass on Sunday
May 7	Confirmation Rehearsal
May 10	Confirmation Mass at 7:00 p.m.

We will discuss this schedule in greater detail at the parent-student meeting on September 25.

Enrollment for Confirmation preparation will begin in August. Enrollment forms will be available online, in the church office, and at the parent-student meeting on September 25. *Note: this form is different from the regular Faith Formation enrollment form. It is a separate form that must be completed specifically for sacramental preparation.*
