



# From our Pastor

Dear friends in the Risen Lord,

The Church knows how to celebrate! It fills the deep night of Holy Saturday with the Light of Christ that finally and utterly shatters the darkness. The great Easter Vigil is followed by Sunday after Sunday of reflections on the triumph of light over darkness and life over death.

In the morning on Easter Sunday we began a 50-day celebration of the presence of the Risen Lord among his stunned disciples. Their unapologetic proclamations become a lens that opens ever wider to let in ever more revealing light. The Church is mindful of the newly baptized as it calls us to remember our own baptism, our own passing from death to life in Christ. We are grateful for the story of Thomas, who is so like us; for the story of the great catch of fish and the command to "Feed my sheep"; for the command to "love one another;" and for the promise of the Holy Spirit.

It is well for us to remember that those who first heard the Easter proclamation were in exactly the same position relative to the risen Christ as we are. Their faith was based on the apostolic witnesses, who experienced Jesus as alive, and believed in him as Lord and Messiah. It is no more difficult or easy for us to make this the center of our lives than it was for those who first believed.

Whether the proclamation "Christ is risen!" is spoken in amazement in Aramaic or written with quills on vellum in Latin, or tapped out on a computer or in a tweet, the reality remains precisely the same: Our lives as baptized people must validate this proclamation. The life of Christ who is risen has been given to us. We must receive it wholly and live it daily. Wherever we find ourselves, there we are. And there is where salvation is possible. This was true yesterday; it is true today; and it will be true always.

We have 50 days to celebrate all of this. We have a lifetime to ponder it.

# WORKING IN ST. VINCENT'S VINEYARD

While reaching out to support the poor, our Vincentians discover many reasons for the immediate need for help.

Incarceration of a spouse is discovered from time to time, and that makes it very hard on the family, even if the other spouse has a job. A recent case in Decatur makes this point all too real. A single Mother of 4 children ranging in age from 1 to 7 years old works for \$9/hour at a day care center. She received no other aid, not even food stamps. The Father in the picture is incarcerated, unable to help with paying the bills, so she fell behind.

Our Vincentians discovered this and more details when they met her during a Home Visit. Seeing firsthand how the poor actually live allows the Vincentians to better understand, better empathize and better make recommendations on the best way to help. They do this by listening carefully (as Monsignor Al says "listening with their eyes") and saying some supportive prayers too. The immediate need was to keep the lights on, so a past due electric bill was paid. Plus, they made a trip to the food pantry and they also got her a new battery for her car so she could keep working. There was a hope that the spouse would be released within a month, allowing more stability for this family.

Thanks to our generous IHM parishioners, St. Vincent DePaul was able to quickly assist this family and keep the lights on and more.

# TRABAJANDO EN EL VIÑEDO DE SAN VICENTE

Mientras se esfuerzan por ayudar a los pobres, nuestros Vicentinos descubren muchas razones para la necesidad inmediata de ayuda.

Una madre soltera con 4 niños de edades entre 1 y 7 años trabaja por \$ 9/hora en una guardería. Ella no recibe ninguna otra ayuda, ni siquiera cupones de alimentos. El padre está encarcelado, y no puede ayudar a pagar las cuentas, por lo cual se encontraba atrasada en sus pagos.

Nuestros Vicentinos descubrieron esto y más detalles durante una visita al hogar. En primer lugar el ver cómo viven realmente los pobres les permite a los vicentinos comprender mejor, identificarse mejor y hacer recomendaciones sobre la mejor forma de poderles ayudar. Hacen esto escuchando atentamente (como Monseñor Al dice "escuchando con los ojos") y haciendo algunas oraciones de apo-

La necesidad inmediata era mantener las luces encendidas, por lo que se pagó una factura de electricidad atrasada. Además, la llevaron a la despensa de alimentos, y también le dieron una batería nueva para su auto para que pudiera seguir trabajando. Había una esperanza de que el cónyuge fuera liberado en un mes, lo que permitiría una mayor estabilidad para esta familia.

Gracias a nuestros generosos feligreses de IHM del San Vicente de Paul se pudo ayudar rápidamente a esta familia, mantener las luces encendidas de su hogar y más.
