

MINISTERS OF HOLY COMMUNION TO THE SICK

Pastoral care of Catholics in hospitals and other healthcare facilities is the responsibility of the parish in whose boundaries the facility is located. While IHM priests and deacons try to visit our parishioners at any hospital, rehab center, personal care home or assisted living facility, our parish is primarily responsible for providing sacramental care at the facilities that lie within our boundaries.

In addition to our clergy, we have a very dedicated cadre of Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion who bring the Sacrament to these facilities on a regular basis. You often see them receiving the Blessed Sacrament from the presider at the foot of the altar at the end of Holy Communion at Mass. Yet the need for pastoral care of the sick now exceeds the resources of these very dedicated volunteers.

If you are presently an Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion and you assist only at our Masses, please consider whether you might also be willing and able to bring Holy Communion to the sick from time to time. GETTING TO KNOW OUR FAITH FORMATION PROGRAMS



EDGE: a program designed for 6th-8th graders to teach them how they were created to be in Christ and helps them understand their mission.

Life Teen: a program designed for 9th-12th graders. Its mission is to lead teenagers and their families closer to Christ. Life Teen will strengthen our teens' Catholic identity, while rooting them firmly in Christ and in His Church.

Both groups meet Sunday evenings from 6:15 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. during the school year. Enroll for the 2019-2020 school year at the link above.

Q. *When is my child eligible to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation?*

A. All Confirmation candidates must be baptized, practicing Catholics, in the 10th grade or higher. They must have received at least two years of religious education immediately prior to being confirmed. If you are in a Catholic high school, you are getting your religious education at school and only need to attend the Confirmation preparation program. If you are in a non-Catholic high school, you need to attend Life Teen for 2 years (the 2019-2020 school year will count as one full year) *and* attend the Confirmation preparation program.

Confirmation will take place in the spring of 2020. The exact date will be available within the next few weeks, along with further details on the Confirmation preparation program for 2019-2020. Check the bulletin and IHM website for updates.


