ADVENT CONFESSIONS: Monsignor Al and Father Carlos will hear drive-up confessions outdoors on Wednesday evenings, December 2, 9 and 16, 7:00-8:00 p.m.; and Saturday mornings, December 5, 12 and 19, 9:00-10:00 a.m. Please enter from Briarcliff on the upper driveway, and follow directions to the first available confessor. Penitents will not leave their cars, and to maintain privacy, there can be only one person in the car.

To the Immaculate Heart of Mary Parish Family:

In partnership with Rich Plachta, Business Manager, the Parish Finance Council has prepared this update to keep you informed about the financial status of the parish. For this update, we are presenting comparison of the income and expenses for the First Quarter of Fiscal Year 2020-2021 (July-September) vs. First Quarter of Fiscal Year 2019-2020.

Given the impacts and uncertainty of COVID, we submitted a revised budget to the Archdiocese in May reflecting an estimated 20% reduction in Offertory Collections when compared to the First Quarter of the 2019-2020 period. We have included the revised budget in the accompanying schedule for reference. Although our Offertory revenues of \$391,791 exceeded our revised budget of \$352,088, we are well short of the \$440,035 in the First Quarter of the prior year. With recent spikes in COVID cases, we are hopeful but realize meeting our budgeted targets may be in jeopardy, as it may take longer to return to some sort of normalcy than we hoped.

Once again, IHM parishioners are to be commended for providing the financial support necessary to allow us to provide all liturgies, faith formation and ministries that are possible during these times. While Offertory, Faith Formation and Divine Playtime revenues were \$48,244, \$11,131 and \$10,319, respectively less than last year, extraordinary one-time donations of more than \$111,000 allowed us to

end the quarter in a manageable cash position. As we cautiously added live Masses during the quarter, it was encouraging to see that electronic giving as a percent of total offertory continued to increase to 65%. We thank you for your continued generosity and commitment to our parish and take the stewardship of these funds as our utmost responsibility.

Overall expenses for the First Quarter amounted to \$461,816, which were \$71,514 less than the First Quarter of the prior year. The decrease resulted from reduced liturgical cost, deferral of faith formation programs, savings from unfilled staff positions and a \$34,480 reduction in Schools Subsidy by the Archdiocese.

Second Collections in the Quarter included donations for Parish Debt Reduction of \$25,688 and Finish in Faith contributions of \$8,661; \$20,634 was received to assist with the mortgage on the new rectory. Thank you for your generosity.

ON THE DISMISSAL OF CATECHUMENS

Although you will not see it if you are watching Mass online, we are continuing the ancient tradition of *dismissing catechumens* from our 11:30 Mass each Sunday. (If you tune in to the livestreamed Spanish Mass, you will see this happen at 6:00 pm each Saturday).

Catechumens are adults or older children who are preparing to be baptized, confirmed, and welcomed to the Eucharist at Easter. They have already made a public commitment to the church and are thus recognized as a part of our community. As such, they have a distinct role to play in our worship. While they cannot yet participate in the Eucharist, they do participate fully in the Liturgy of the Word, and so we invite them to continue reflecting on God's Word together (though safely distanced) in a separate place during the Liturgy of the Eucharist. Indeed, in the early centuries of the church, the Liturgy of the Word was also known as the Liturgy of Catechumens.

What about those of us who stay behind—or watch from home? Our role is to pray for these catechumens, that they will continue to walk with Christ and allow his Word to grow within them week by week.
