## FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear friends in the Lord,

The most recent guidance from the CDC, and the Covid statistics for DeKalb County in particular, are very encouraging. No one wants to “declare victory” over the pandemic only to see the appearance of yet another variant or another surge, and the situation in Hong Kong this week is a cautionary tale. But it certainly looks like it may be time for us to revisit some of the liturgical procedures we have in place at IHM.

As you learned last weekend, masks are now optional during Mass for most people. Beginning during the Sacred Triduum and Easter: (1) We will resume scheduling a full complement of altar servers at each weekend Mass, and they will assume all of their former responsibilities; (2) Ushers will resume passing the baskets for the collections; (3) The deacon or priest will once again invite us to offer the sign of peace, and we will all use common sense and Christian charity as we do so, respecting the preferences of those around us; (4) We will once again offer Holy Communion on the tongue to communicants who desire to receive in that manner; (5) The Sunday nursery will reopen in the church lower level during Masses where there is a need.

To make these and other adjustments in our worship, it will be necessary for *all* liturgical ministers, including those who are currently active, to receive a “re-orientation.” This is also an excellent opportunity for new members to join any of our liturgical ministries! We will need the help! Please note the following orientation session:

- ♦ **Altar Servers** will meet Wednesday, March 16 at 2:30 p.m. or Monday, March 21, 7-8:00 p.m.
- ♦ **Lectors** will meet Monday, March 28, 7-8:00 p.m.
- ♦ **Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion** will meet Sun, April 3, 7-8:00 p.m.
- ♦ **Ministers of Hospitality (Ushers)** will meet Wednesday, March 16, 7-8:00 p.m.
