KEEPING LENT AT IHM

ABSTINENCE FROM MEAT is observed by all Catholics 14 years and older on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and all the Fridays of Lent.

FASTING is observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday by all Catholics who are 18 years of age but not yet 59. Those bound by this rule may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted as necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs.

DAILY MASS is celebrated Monday-Friday and first Saturday mornings at 8:30 in English and Thursday evenings at 7:00 in Spanish.

THE SACRAMENT OF PENANCE is offered on the Saturdays of Lent at 9:00 a.m. and on Thursdays at 5:30 p.m.

OUR LENT PENANCE SERVICE is Monday, March 6 at 7:00 p.m. Monsignor Al and Father Robbie will have the assistance of many neighboring priest confessors, so this is your best opportunity to experience the healing of Reconciliation before Easter.

There will be no confessions during the Sacred Triduum: Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS will be observed on Fridays, February 24 through March 31, at 7:00 p.m. in English and at 8:00 p.m. in Spanish.

FISH FRIES will be offered by the IHM Men's Group on each of the Fridays of Lent, February 24 to March 31, 6:00-8:00 p.m., in the school cafeteria. Meals will be available for dining in or take-out. You can preorder your meals on the parish website. Come keep your Lenten abstinence from meat in the company of your parish family!

OUR PARISH MUSTARD SEED MISSIONS to Jamaica and the Dominican Republic are a special penitential work of mercy that we can undertake together during Lent. Today, and on each Sunday of Lent, there will be a box in the narthex to receive your monetary gifts for Mustard Seed. God bless your Lenten solidarity with those in need around the world.

WORKING IN ST. VINCENT'S VINEYARD

The mother of 4 children was despairing of her situation. She had been living with them in a room at an area extended stay motel not far from IHM for 6 weeks. Her children do not attend school. She has no job. She receives no government nor private agency assistance. The father of the children is unreliable and mostly out of the picture. The motel manager was demanding more money to stay. That's when she reached out to St. Vincent de Paul.

Our Vincentian talked with her at length on the phone to learn more about the details of her situation. She was desperate and sounded depressed. However, she was trying to navigate the bureaucratic maze that exists to help those in need. She was waiting for one more document that would allow her to stay longer at the motel, but the document just didn't come.

She wanted to work but was not able to leave her children without care. She wished they had some form of health insurance in case they got sick.

The first step was to get them food to subsist. The second was to pay for an added week to buy time for the government form to arrive. Later, our Vincentian followed up and found out they were to be evicted that very day! In this case, we quickly extended her one more week to keep them sheltered from the winter cold.

We will follow up again shortly. She was very appreciative of our help and support. Unfortunately our ability to offer her longer-term resources is limited, despite ongoing efforts to empower Vincentians in our North Georgia area with better tools to help.

Thanks to the generosity of our IHM parishioners, we were able to keep her family sheltered and fed in their dark days. All are praying for that form to arrive and for their eventual return to a stable life.
