### NOTES FROM FR. FRED

Dear IHM Parish Family:

It's wonderful to see our young people returning to school at our Catholic school and all the schools that are youth attend. It's great to see our Religious Education programs beginning again. It was a pleasure this past Sunday to walk around and meet our families and children. Whether this weekend in my encounters with our families or this past week when I spoke at school to our Pre-K through 5th grade parents or created a video for our Middle School parents; I reminded all, that parents are the **PRIMARY RELIGIOUS EDUCATORS** of their children. We as priests, deacons, church and school faculty and staff assist parents in this very serious endeavor. I and Fr. Robbie thank our families for their commitment.

It's so connected when, this coming weekend in the gospel, Jesus asks Peter and the Apostles: "Who do you say that I am?" Peter responds: "You are the Christ, the Son of the Living God." It's an acknowledgment by Peter of who Jesus really is. It's also ultimately an acknowledgment by the Church, that as the Body of Christ, this is our call to come and know Jesus as our Savior personally, but also as His Body the Church in community and fellowship. **WE ARE A COMMUNITY OF FAITH.** We are the those who gather to pray and celebrate Eucharist. It's one of the things that's so important. I want that our young people see that the teachings of our church are tied into our journey of faith in relationship with the Lord and one another.

In our world today, there is so much that wants to separate us from our faith or tell us it's not important. I pray that those voices are countered by other voices that speak the **TRUTH** that only God can speak. The **TRUTH** that Jesus is **THE WAY, THE TRUTH and THE LIFE.** Let's remember the Opening Prayer for this weekend in the 21<sup>st</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time:

"O God, who cause the minds of the faithful to unite in a single purpose, grant your people to love what you command and to desire what you promise, that, amid the uncertainties of this world, our hearts may be fixed on that place where true gladness is found."

### AIDS MINISTRY SUPPORTS CLIENTS AT MERCY CARE HIV/AIDS CLINIC: AN UNTOLD STORY

For the past few years, the **AIDS Ministry** has provided about 150 bags of personal care items to uninsured and underinsured clients living with HIV/AIDS who are treated at the Early Intervention Clinic (EIC) at **Mercy Care** in downtown Atlanta. In April youth group members assisted the Ministry with assembly of the bags. We asked the **EIC team** to tell us about the clients who receive these bags and how they are distributed and used by clients. Here is what the team told us:

*"Many of our clients are indigent, homeless, or living with limited income. Even those clients who are employed often have need of assistance. Many live with family members, such as a grandmother who cares for a client's children, in order to avoid being homeless. For these clients, this support is even more substantial and needed."*

*The bags received from IHM AIDS Ministry are distributed daily to clients. They contain personal care items (e.g., bath soap, towels, toothbrushes, shampoo) and household cleaning items (e.g., detergent, dishwashing soap, cleanser). These everyday items are often taken for granted, but to the clients receiving them, they are a God send. We are always greeted with such gratitude from those receiving the bags. Every item, from body soap to household cleaner and hair products, is greatly appreciated. We are ever so grateful to the IHM AIDS Ministry for this support to our health care service and our clients."*

**AIDS Ministry** members purchase the items and assemble 20 bags per session about 3-4 times per year.
