Notes from Fr. Fred

Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

On Monday the 28th of August, we had our Parish Leadership Dinner in the "Historic Church". Most of our ministry leaders were able to attend. We started with prayer, then a dinner. After our dinner, I gave a presentation for about an hour. I invited the leaders to leave their tables and pull their chairs up to the front to be around myself at the podium. I felt it important that we come closer together as I shared news about the parish. Most especially, I wanted to speak to some of my ideas for the future of Immaculate Heart of Mary. Having interviewed our Parish Staff and reviewed their job descriptions, I spoke of how pleased I was with our staff and their commitment to the parish and its mission. I also spoke to areas that I felt we needed to give more attention, with the hope of eventually adding a couple more staff positions. The two positions I'm most focused on currently are: Director of Parish Ministries and Director of Communications. Coordinating our ministries, working with leaders in the parish community, encouraging, assisting, recruiting, expanding and improving communications around the parish is very important to me. I so very much want us to continue to build up this community of faith. More information will come on these ideas as we move into the future. I look forward to more ideas on how we can serve our church better within and outside in the greater community.

I also brought people up to date on the renovation of the historic church. At the present time we have approximately \$2.7 million raised in cash and pledges. The cost of the project will be \$4.1 million. We've received permission to borrow up to \$1.5 million. My intention is to come back to you, the parish, and invite those who have not contributed, to please consider doing so. I'd also like that we consider expanding the pledge drive from 3 years to 5 years with the hope that you might be open to raising your pledged amount with a longer time to complete your commitment. Although I come into the parish after the initial pledge drive has been completed, I do believe this is a very worthy project. It's exciting to think that IHM might finally have its own parish center and a nice one at that!

Again, thank you all for your prayers and commitment to this faith community. DON'T FORGET OUR **PARISH PICNIC** COMING UP ON **SEPTEMBER 23rd!** We're going to have a DUNK TANK for Fr. Robbie and myself. Come and enjoy the opportunity to put us in the water!
