WORKING IN ST. VINCENT'S VINEYARD

Here we are, deep into Advent and the building anticipation of the celebrations surrounding the birth of Christ. The Poor, whom we serve, are also feeling gratitude for the help they have recently received from IHM St. Vincent de Paul via the Thanksgiving and Christmas efforts so firmly supported by our parish.

However, not all are free from worry, anxiety, and stress during this season. Being among The Poor in 2023 can mean facing hunger, eviction, and loss of dignity. These issues are multiplied when small children are at risk.

You see, the grinding issues of The Poor never take a holiday. The eviction courts run full time in December.

A recent Neighbor in Need faced eviction with her 5 children under the age of 6. She was also expecting a new baby too. Our Vincentian first met her to better understand her needs, with eviction being imminent. At a follow up call, the Vincentian learned she had split with her unmarried partner, taken 4 of the 5 kids, and had relocated to a different apartment.

Fortunately, she had a stable government job. However, it paid far less than her former partner had made, and she needed help with the first month's rent. She plans to work overtime to earn more money, but doing so puts pressure on her for childcare while she works. With the eviction no longer hounding her, our Vincentian prioritized getting her food and clothing vouchers as well as a half month payment towards her rent.

Her long-term stability is in doubt. Her job plus her tenacity to get up every day and face the grinding nature of poverty should serve her well. Thanks to the ongoing tremendous support from our IHM parishioners, we were able to keep her, and the children housed, fed, and clothed for the short term.
