

#### **WORKING IN ST. VINCENT'S VINEYARD**

Serving The Poor, the mission of the St. Vincent de Paul Society, on face value is quite simple. Knowing that every person is created in the image and likeness of God, Vincentians are moved to support The Poor in any reasonable way to make their lives safer, more secure, and more protected from the challenges life will throw at them. And to do so without judgment.

In reality, the mission is more complicated. Vincentians, once trained, need to amp up their empathy, build patience, and learn the intricacies of situations arising due to homelessness, food insecurity, domestic abuse, employment problems, and medication needs.

The 62 IHM Vincentians could not accomplish their mission without the direct support of the IHM parish community. All are volunteers, seeking to do something beyond themselves to help The Poor. Their reward is the inner joy of giving back that cannot be found in most aspects of daily life.

In 2023 our IHM parishioners donated \$180,000 to our Conference of St. Vincent DePaul, directly serving 530 families and over 1,000 persons. In addition, over \$35,000 was raised in the form of In-Kind Aid (food and clothing).

The recently completed Thanksgiving dinner program served 415 families. The Christmas Giving Tree program provided gifts to 329 children.

The ongoing generosity of our parish community is inspiring! Without your support, none of these families would receive the help they need.
