

THE EASTER TRIDUUM is the center, the heart of the year for Catholics. These are days to save and savor.

Adults are invited to plan ahead so that, to the extent possible, the whole time from Thursday night until the Easter Vigil is free of social engagements, work, entertainment and meals—except for the simplest nourishment. We are asked to fast during Good Friday and to continue fasting, if possible, all through Holy Saturday, so that we come hungry and full of excitement to the Easter Vigil.

Whether you are young or old, currently active in the parish or not, please set these days aside. All of us should know that our presence for the liturgies of the Paschal Triduum is not just by invitation. We are all needed here. All of us need the whole community together on its greatest days.

On these Three Days, we gather a number of times with each other. Together we hear some of the church's most beautiful prayers and scriptures, and we make some of our finest music. Please look closely at the parish schedule below and make plans now to take part in the liturgies of Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday.

WORKING IN ST. VINCENT'S VINEYARD

The perfect storm of back-to-back events pushed her close to the edge. This 43-year-old divorced mother of 4 was facing eviction and needed support.

As is frequently seen when serving The Poor, people can go along fine until a series of events knocks them down. In her case, it began with her mother's terminal illness in Miami, Florida. She took several trips to visit her in her last weeks and then paid for the funeral.

That might have worked out had her company not laid her off, along with many others. Then, her food stamps were stolen from her mailbox. Then, her landlord raised her rent by \$400 a month.

She could not keep up with this cascade of bad news. She fell behind in her rent, putting her and her children at risk of homelessness.

She reached out to St. Vincent de Paul a few days after eviction.

Our Vincentians met with her to listen carefully to her situation and assess her needs. They also gathered information and said some prayers.


The good news is that she has a degree in criminal justice and is resourceful, which implies that she could manage things well if she could get past the string of negative events.

She was taking interviews for a new job in Pennsylvania, a few minutes from her brother's home. She got the job, plus the benefit of living closer to family.

Our Vincentians recommended we go above and beyond our normal support levels to help her with a deposit on a new rental home.

Thanks to the generosity of our IHM parish, we broke the string of adverse events. We assisted her in avoiding eviction, putting her and her family on a path to stability.

THE THIRD SCRUTINY

"The One Jesus Loved"

"Master, the one you love is ill." *The one you love*. To modern, meritocratic ears, it sounds scandalous, the suggestion that Jesus would love anyone in a special or disproportionate way. Doesn't God love all of us equally? Isn't there a baseline of fairness that we can depend on in the life of grace? But we hear the refrain throughout John's gospel. There is a particular disciple among the twelve whom Jesus loves in a special way. And he shows unique affection toward this family—the evangelist reiterates that he "loved Martha and her sister and Lazarus." Some commentators, drawing upon this and other hints in the text, speculate that Lazarus was disabled or incapacitated in some way. This would certainty fit what we know of the Lord—that he would give special attention to a disabled man and his caretakers.

Raising Lazarus was the ultimate sign of Jesus' divine authority. But it also shows us Jesus at his most human. He was clearly "in his feelings" here. He wept for Lazarus—he was "perturbed and deeply troubled." His greatest miracle occurred in his most vulnerable moment. Perhaps the point is to prove that Christ loves us, never in the abstract, but always in a fiercely particular way. It is a point that I pray the Elect will take to heart during these final days of preparation. Throughout Lent, we have singled them out, called them by name, invited them to the front of the church, and given them our special blessings. Why do we lavish such attention on this handful of people every year? The simple answer is that Jesus is opening his heart to them through these gestures. And at Easter, he's going to raise them from the dead.

THE BOOK OF THE ELECT

At the Rite of Election on Saturday, February 17, Archbishop Hartmayer accepted our seventeen catechumens and declared them "Elect," marking the final stage of their preparation for the Easter sacraments. Their names are written in the Book of the Elect, which was presented to the Archbishop at the Rite.

The Book of the Elect will remain in the church throughout Lent, in the niche by the baptismal font. Please pray for our Elect by name throughout this season of purification and enlightenment.
