



\$40 buy-in includes 10 general games, 1 special \$200 game, 1 special black out \$500 game and a bingo dauber.


Single session games sold for \$3 each, \$200 game cards sold at \$5 each and black out games sold at \$10 each. \$1.00 game cards payout 50/50 split



All About Safe Environment Training

Parents must order meals online for each day. Currently, Wholesome Food Services delivers food from the area restaurants shown above. To register and order from Wholesome Food, follow these instructions:

- Go to <u>www.wholesomefoodservices.com</u>
- Select Register to create an account
- Set up a profile for each child by selecting Add Profile
- Select Order Now to view menus and place orders
- When you place your first order, you will enter your credit card/debit card information to pay securely online.

Your order must be received before 1:00 pm the day before. You can order up to 60 days in advance.
