

How to Handle Allergies



This year allergy sufferers are noticing earlier symptoms, such as: watery, itchy eyes, runny nose, sneezing, coughing, and sinus like headaches.


Welcome Spring, trees and shrubs are blooming, and cars are covered in yellow and green pollen. So, for those kids and adults with seasonal allergies, it can be a miserable time.

Allergies and viral symptoms can be similar but there are some key differences. For example, think about the timeline. Does your child always have problems this time of the year?

Second, check for fever. Allergies do not cause fever.

OTC's, or Over the Counter medications, can be helpful. Check with your local pharmacy or drug store as to the various options, or consult your childs' pediatrician if their allergies are more severe.
