October 15, 2023 Twenty-eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time



Jesus gives us another parable in today's Gospel from Matthew. The invited guests who refused to come represent the Jewish leaders of that time, just like the tenant farmers from the Parable of the Tenants. The King is God, of course, and the Bridegroom, the King's Son, is Jesus. The wedding guests had been invited at least three times representing God's repeated and patient attempts to call His people back to Him through the prophets. As with the Parable of the Tenants, the Jewish people had rejected God's invitation each time. God had sent the Old Testament prophets to the nation of Israel to call His people to repentance and back to fellowship with Him. They had rejected those offers and had rejected God Himself. God gave the Jewish people chance after chance to come to Him just as He gives us chance after chance to turn from ourselves and to turn to His Son, Jesus Christ. So, are you wearing the right clothes? Are you clothed in Jesus' righteousness? If you were to face God today, what would you say to Him?

So, are we prepared and wearing the "proper clothes" to enter into God's Kingdom. We cannot come to God on the basis of our

own good deeds. It does not work that way. It is God's Kingdom. It is God's Son. It is His wedding banquet. We do not get to decide the terms of His invitation.

"Radical Solidarity" is what Jesus lived in becoming a human being like us, bringing the truth and power of God's salvation to us in all our afflictions through his words and deeds, and sacrificing his life for us on the cross to save us from sin and death. Pope St. John Paul II taught: "It is precisely by his death that Jesus reveals all the splendor and value of life, inasmuch as his self-oblation on the Cross becomes the source of new life for all people (cf. Jn 12:32) In his journeying amid contradictions and in the very loss of his life Jesus is guided by the certainty that his life is in the hands of the Father. Consequently, on the Cross, he can say to him: "Father, into your hands I commend my spirit!" (Lk 23:46), that is, my life. Truly great must be the value of human life if the Son of God has taken it up and made it the instrument of the salvation of all humanity" (The Gospel of Life, #33, p. 36).

Worldwide Marriage Encounter:


