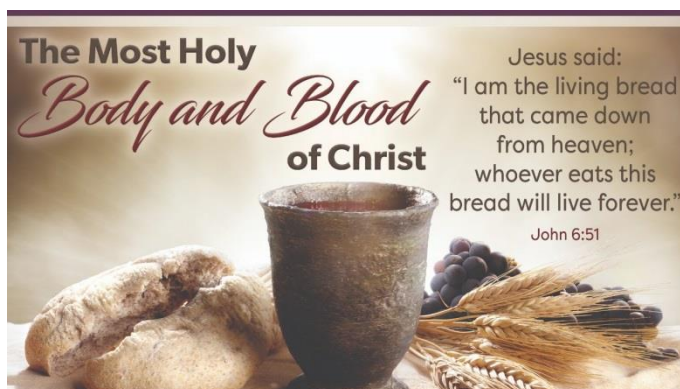

solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ

June 11, 2023



When we receive the Eucharist, Christ is present. We connect to God and receive grace in that moment in a singular, particular way that is unique to us. We are in communion with God. The “restless heart” that St. Augustine speaks of is held still for one quiet moment.

There is also a connection to the church as a whole. We pray with the grandmother whispering over candles in a small village church in Italy, with the families in China living under persecution, and with the Nigerian seminarian moments before he was martyred.

There is a sense in which the Eucharist is timeless, out of time, eternal, or, as I recently read, a panorama of salvation history. We look to the past, remembering Christ’s resurrection. We look at the present, our relationship with him now. We look to the future, his second coming. As we look back in this moment, we also connect to

the faithful who have come before us: the apostles, saints, and our eighth-grade math teacher who prayed over the class roster. As we look forward into the future, we see Christ's second coming, the feast of the marriage supper of the lamb. We see when all creation will be reconciled, when all will be made new, when sin no longer separates us from experiencing God fully. Our existence will not be this glimpse of heaven but will be heaven.

Volunteer drivers Wanted:

More than 40 percent of older and disabled adults rely on family, friends and neighbors for rides. But providing transportation is not always easy or convenient. Some family caregivers just can't leave their job every time somebody needs a ride to the doctor, much less even to the grocery store. In rural areas where there are no other options such as public transportation, the need is even greater. Melissa Stern, the Community Health Worker for Sanford in Hillsboro has been working with groups such as Valley Senior Transportation and others to provide transportation for those in need, such as residents of Kiwanis Housing, to get to medical, dental appointments or even trips to the bank. Many residents lack the ability or finances to get to their appointments, and may not qualify for other community resources. Melissa is spearheading an effort to provide assistance to those in need. There are three ways in which you could help;

- 1) Volunteer as a driver. There is a sign-up sheet in the back of the church.
 - 2) Donate toward the cost of "punch cards" for rides on the Senior Transport van. Donations may be sent to the Hillsboro Senior Center.
 - 3) Donate gas cards in increments of \$5-10. Cards can be left here at church in envelope addressed to Dcn Curt, or mailed to him directly.

The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ

We celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ on this Sunday, June 11th. It is traditionally known in Latin as “Corpus Christi”, meaning “Body of Christ”. At the Last Supper in the course of the Passover meal on the night before he died, Jesus instituted the Holy Eucharist by saying about the bread, “This is my body,” and about the wine, “This is my blood.” In receiving the Body of Christ at Holy Communion, we are receiving the whole Christ, “the body and blood, together with the soul and divinity, of our Lord Jesus Christ” (Catechism of the Catholic Church, #1374, p. 346). This is why we believe in the “real presence” of Christ in the Holy Eucharist. In addition to the Holy Mass, the source and summit of our faith, we will celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ and worship Christ in the Holy Eucharist by exposing the Blessed Sacrament and having Adoration after the prayer after Holy Communion at each of our Masses at St. Rose of Lima Church and St. William’s Church on Saturday evening and Sunday morning. We will have Adoration for a half hour and Benediction at the end of Adoration. You may stay and pray for a few minutes or for the whole half hour. Let us thank and praise Jesus for how he remains with us in the Holy Eucharist to feed us, refresh us, sanctify us, and give us eternal life. --- Msgr. Skonseng
