June 4, 2023 The Solemnity of The Most Holy Trinity



Of all the great feasts we celebrate within the Church throughout the year, today's Solemnity presents us with a Mystery that is so deep and transcendent that our eternity will be spent in perpetual contemplation. The Trinity, the life of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit, will never get old, never be fully understood, and will be the cause of our everlasting adoration and joy.

The Father, Son and Holy Spirit are Persons. And as Persons, they want to be known. And they want to be known primarily through a life of deep and intimate prayer. Praying to One Person, of course, is praying to all, since they are One God. But we are, nonetheless, called to a relationship of love with the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. And though our feeble minds may not be able to fully comprehend the essence of God, He will draw us deeper and deeper into a knowledge of Him if we let Him.

Reflect, today, upon the Most Holy Trinity. As you do, say a prayer to God asking for a deeper and more intimate knowledge of Him. Ask Him to communicate to you His divine love and to open

your mind and heart to a deeper understanding of Who He is. Try to humble yourself before the great Mystery of the inner life of God. Humility before the Mystery of God means that we know how little we know about Him and how little we know of Him. But that humble truth will help you move closer to the deeper relationship of love to which you are called.

Volunteer drivers Wanted:

More than 40 percent of older and disabled adults rely on family, friends and neighbors for rides. But providing transportation is not always easy or convenient. Some family caregivers just can't leave their job every time somebody needs a ride to the doctor, much less even to the grocery store. In rural areas where there are no other options such as public transportation, the need is even greater. Melissa Stern, the Community Health Worker for Sanford in Hillsboro has been working with groups such as Valley Senior Transportation and others to provide transportation for those in need, such as residents of Kiwanis Housing, to get to medical, dental appointments or even trips to the bank. Many residents lack the ability or finances to get to their appointments, and may not qualify for other community resources. Melissa is spearheading an effort to provide assistance to those in need. There are three ways in which you could help;

- 1) Volunteer as a driver. There is a sign-up sheet in the back of the church.
- 2) Donate toward the cost of "punch cards" for rides on the Senior Transport van. Donations may be sent to the Hillsboro Senior Center.
- 3) Donate gas cards in increments of \$5-10. Cards can be left here at church in envelope addressed to Dcn Curt, or mailed to him directly.
