## August 13, 2023 Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Today's reading from Cospel of Catthew is the story of the apostles being tossed about a violent storm at sea. The wind was so fierce that the apostles were terrified that their boat would sink and they might even die! When Jesus walked on the water toward men it seems that they would have been reassured. Instead they became even more afraid.

Even when Jesus spoke to them and reassured them that it truly was him, they still did not believe! Peter replies, "If it really is you, Jesus, let me come to you." Peter needed proof that this "apparition" truly was Jesus. Jesus heeded Peter's request by simply replying, "Come."

We all have some doubts inside us like Peter did. We often ask for "proof" of Jesus' presence, Jesus' call. In turbulent or painful times is Jesus also asking us to trust? Are we willing to take the risk, step out and make that "trust walk," believing that Jesus will enable us to get through our difficult times? Let us pray for the grace to trust that Jesus is always with us — especially when we need him the most!

#### Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary:

On Tuesday, August 15th, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Regarding the Assumption, the Church teaches: "Finally the Immaculate Virgin, preserved free from all stain of original sin, when the course of her earthly life was finished, was taken up body and soul into heavenly glory, and exalted by the Lord as Queen over all things, so that she might be the more fully conformed to her Son, the Lord of lords and conqueror of sin and death" (Catechism of the Catholic Church, #966, p. 252). It is a Holy Day of Obligation. Masses will be on Monday, August 14th, at 7:00 PM at St. William's Church, Argusville, and on Tuesday, August 15th, at 7:30 AM and 7:00 PM at St. Rose of Lima Church, Hillsboro. The sacrament of Reconciliation will be available a half hour before each Mass. We ask for the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary that we may be taken up into heaven by the Lord and glorified in body and soul at His final coming. --- Msgr. Skonseng
