

The Epiphany of the Lord

We celebrate the Solemnity of the Epiphany of the Lord this Sunday, January 7th. "The feast which celebrates the manifestation to the world of the newborn Christ as Messiah, Son of God, and Savior of the world. The feast of Epiphany celebrated the adoration of Jesus by the wise men (magi) from the East, together with his baptism in the Jordan and the wedding feast of Cana in Galilee" (Catechism of the Catholic Church, Glossary, p. 876). We recall that the three wise men gave homage to Jesus, the newborn King, and offered him gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh. As we offer ourselves to Jesus at Mass, he offers us to the Father; and we and people of all nations receive abundant gifts from Jesus our Savior and Lord reigning from his throne in heaven.

Synod Assembly for the Third Synod of the Diocese of Fargo

Bishop Folda called for this synod of the Diocese of Fargo on Pentecost Sunday, June 5, 2022. The last diocesan synod was in 1951. When Bishop Folda called for this synod, he said: "I believe we can all see that we are living in an era of change both in our world and in our culture. Some of those changes are positive, and some of them are not. But in the face of those changes, the Church must come to a renewed understanding of her identity as a communion in Christ, the People of God, animated by the grace and gifts of the Holy Spirit. Our diocesan Church is one with the universal Church, and we share in the mission that Jesus gave to his apostles, to 'go make disciples of all nations.' Through this diocesan synod, we will gather in communion and charity to reflect upon the times in which we live, with all their opportunities and challenges. We will discern the grace of the Holy Spirit at work in our diocesan family, and we will accept once more the invitation of our Lord to proclaim the Good News of our faith to the world."

Since the opening of the synod, the Diocese of Fargo has been preparing for the Synod Assembly through listening sessions throughout the diocese and in other ways. The Synod Assembly for the Third Synod of the Diocese of Fargo will soon take place on April 11-13, 2024, in Fargo. The Synod Assembly will include all active priests and deacons of the diocese, delegates from all parishes of the diocese, and other delegates chosen by Bishop Folda. The Directory for the Third Synod of the Diocese of Fargo states: "The purpose of the diocesan synod is to assist the bishop in the exercise of the office proper to him, namely, that of governing the Christian community" (p. 1). It states further: "This diocesan synod is not a parliament which puts the teachings of the Church up for a vote. Rather, it is an instrument for discerning the best way to make available the gifts of the Church, including her timeless doctrines, sacramental life, and pastoral care, to the people of Eastern North Dakota in our concrete circumstances" (p. 1). If the Holy Spirit has placed some instruction or some action on your mind and heart for the diocesan synod to consider, please contact the priest, the deacon, or the delegate of your parish.
