

#### **Blessing of Throats**

The feast day of St. Blaise, bishop and martyr, is on February 3rd. He was believed to have been martyred in the persecution of Licinius, in the early fourth century. He was bishop of Sebaste in Armenia. St. Blaise is associated with the healing of throats because through his intercession a boy was saved from a fish bone stuck in his throat. I have the practice of transferring the blessing of throats to the nearest Sunday. Therefore, we will have the blessing of throats for anyone who wants to receive it at the end of the 5:00 PM Mass at St. Rose of Lima Parish on Saturday, February 3rd, the end of the 8:30 AM Mass at St. William's Parish on Sunday, February 4th, and after the Prayer of the Faithful during the 10:30 AM Mass at St. Rose of Lima Parish on Sunday, February 4th. --- Msgr.
