December 22, 2024 Fourth Sunday of Advent



The Fourth Sunday of Advent tells us that we are approaching the celebration of Christmas. We have prepared ourselves during Advent for Christ's coming to the world. The readings today are in anticipation of His coming and speak of God's promise of salvation – reiterating the theme of obedience to his Word.

The prophet Micah prophesied the coming of the Messiah, who is Jesus Christ, the new King who will bring peace and security to His people not only in Israel, but "to the ends of the land". He also foretells the means of Christ's coming – "when she who is to give birth gives birth", referring to Mary's role in God's divine plan and promise.

Like Mary, through our baptism we are filled with the same Holy Spirit. As we live out our faith in our daily lives, God becomes real in our world today. God asks us to follow Mary's example and say YES. Through our YES we can bring the Kingdom of God into our homes, our families, and in our community. We can make God's love real and visible. Just as God called and chose Mary, God calls and chooses each of us today. Let's follow her faithful example through what we say and do. May we bring Jesus into our world today.

Living Our Faith, Building Our Future

Members of St. Rose of Lima Parish and St. William's Parish, I thank those of you who have given gifts to the Campaign: "Living Our Faith, Building Our Future." The money raised from this campaign will be used for the needs of our priests in their retirement, including a new retirement home in Fargo, and for the renovation and future maintenance of the Maryvale Retreat Center near Valley City. As of December 19, 2024, members of St. Rose of Lima Parish have given \$71,791.92 in pledges and gifts toward our goal of \$107,440, which is about 67% of our goal. Members of St. William's Parish have given \$36,400 in pledges and gifts toward our goal of \$54,933, which is about 66% of our goal. Remember that 30% of the money given will be used for the needs of our parishes. If we exceed our goal, 70% will go back to our parishes. So far 31 of the 194 households of St. Rose of Lima Parish and 13 of 62 households of St. William's Parish who were invited to give to this campaign have given gifts. I hope that more members of our parishes will join me and others who have given to this campaign in making a pledge over the course of four years or what time frame which you choose or making a one-time gift.
