

**REFLECTION:** Ten lepers were healed by Jesus as they showed themselves to the priest. After receiving their healing, only the Samaritan went back to Jesus to thank Him. Sometimes, we just take for granted to be grateful for the ordinary things in our life. To have an honest examine, simple things, ordinary human experiences, and little favors are most often overlooked? We don't pay attention to them. Today, let us identify ourselves to the Samaritan who went back to Jesus to thank Him personally.


