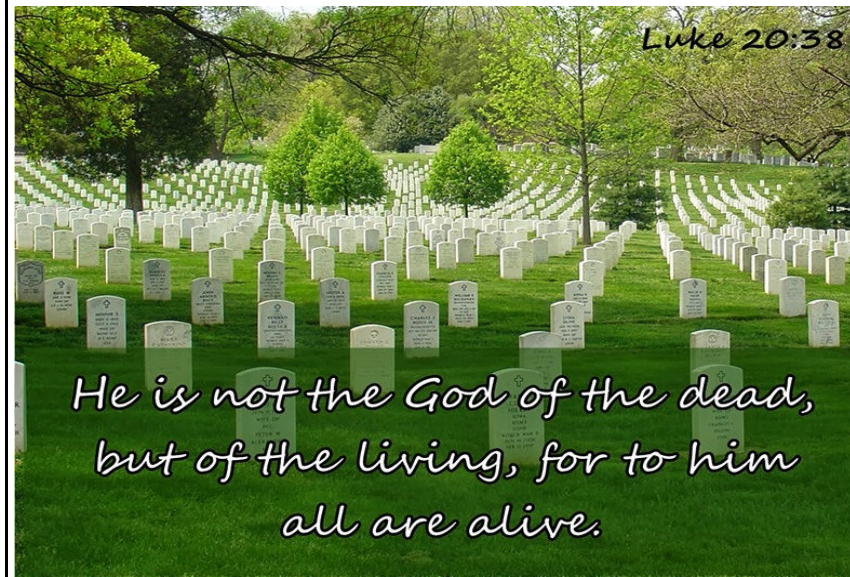
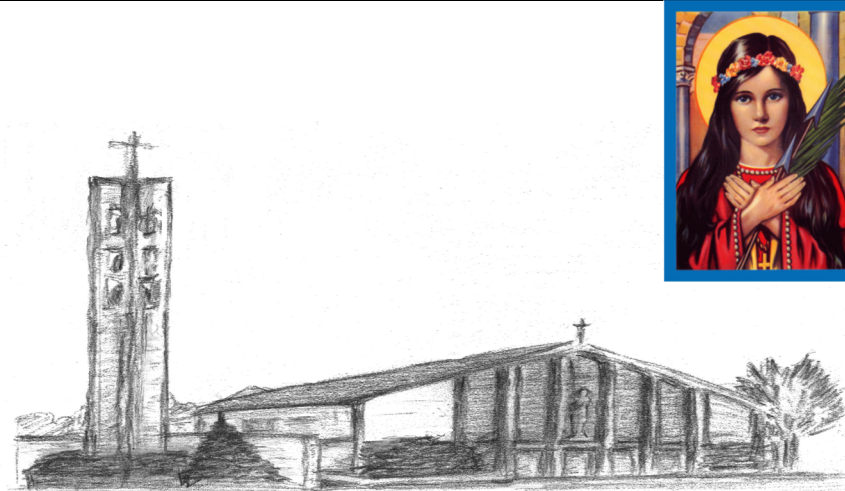

Let Us Pray for Our Priests...

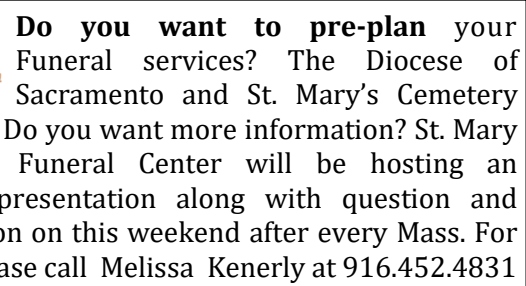
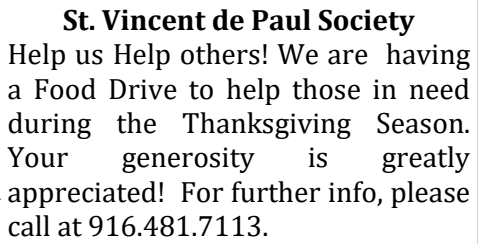

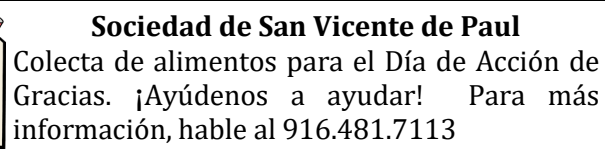
