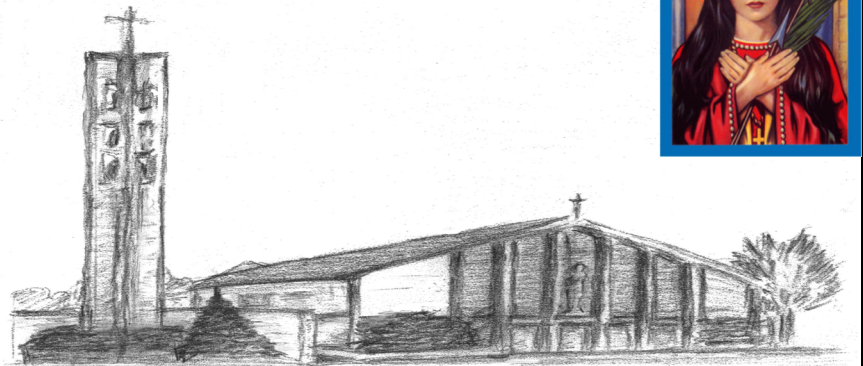

Today's Parable is really about how God will be generous. God pays or rewards our deeds, be it big or small. From the beginning of creation, our God has tremendously been generous.
