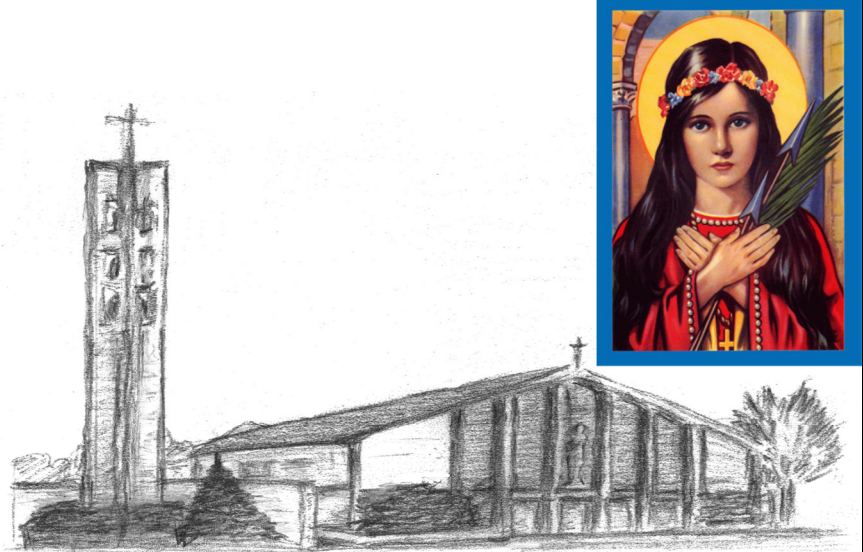

FATHER MARTIN'S CORNER

Today, we are now entering into the last days of Jesus, the Holy Week. Also, today is Palm (Passion) Sunday where it commemorates the triumphant entry of Jesus to Jerusalem. We would like to welcome Jesus into our lives. On Holy Thursday morning, Chrism Mass is celebrated usually in the Cathedral where the Oil of the Sick, the Oil of the Catechumen and the Oil of Sacred Chrism are blessed and at the same time, all the priests in the diocese will renew their Priestly Commitment to service to the Bishop. And in the evening, Paschal/Easter Triduum (Three Days) begins. This day commemorates the Last Supper of Jesus with his disciples. It focuses on the institution of the Eucharist and Priesthood symbolized by the washing, a sign of service. Good Friday is a solemn day where we relive Jesus on his way to Calvary to be crucified in order to save us. May we follow and accompany Jesus on His Way of the Cross. The last day of the Holy Triduum is the Easter Vigil on Saturday evening where we celebrate the most wonderful and faith inspiring liturgical celebration: during the Service of Light, the Paschal (Easter) Candle is lit; in the celebration of the Sacraments of Christian Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and First Communion), finally the Elects are fully incorporated into the Catholic Church. May all the Holy Week services deepen your faith in the Lord as you participate actively and fully in prayer, fasting, abstinence and presence with openness, humility to be transformed by our loving and forgiving God.

Hoy, estamos entrando en los últimos días de Jesús, la Semana Santa. Además, hoy es el Domingo de Ramos (Pasión) donde se conmemora la entrada triunfal de Jesús a Jerusalén. Nos gustaría dar la bienvenida a Jesús en nuestras vidas. El Jueves Santo por la mañana, la misa del Crisma se celebra generalmente en la Catedral donde se bendice el Aceite del Enfermo, el Aceite del Catecúmeno y el Aceite del Crisma Sagrado y al mismo tiempo, todos los sacerdotes de la diócesis renovarían su Compromiso Sacerdotal al servicio del Obispo. Y por la tarde, comienza el Triduo Pascual (Tres Días). Este día conmemora la Última Cena de Jesús con sus discípulos. Se enfoca en la institución de la Eucaristía y el Sacerdocio simbolizada por el lavado, un signo de servicio. El Viernes Santo es un día solemne en el que revivimos a Jesús en su camino al Calvario para que lo crucifiquen y nos salve. Sigamos y acompañemos a Jesús en su camino de la Cruz. El último día del Sagrado Triduo es la Vigilia de Pascua que se celebra el sábado por la noche, donde celebramos la celebración litúrgica más maravillosa e inspiradora de la fe: durante el Servicio de la Luz, se enciende el Sirio Pascual (Pascua); En la celebración de los Sacramentos de Iniciación Cristiana (Bautismo, Confirmación y Primera Comunión), finalmente los elegidos están plenamente incorporados a la Iglesia Católica. Que todos los servicios de la Semana Santa profundicen su fe en el Señor mientras participan activamente y en oración, ayuno, abstinencia y presencia con apertura, humildad para ser transformados por nuestro Dios amable y misericordioso.
