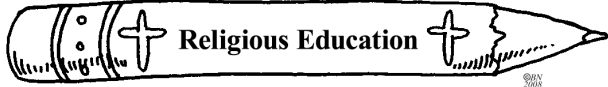

OUR FASCINATING FAITH

Divine Mercy

Saint John Paul II named the Second Sun-
day of Easter "Sunday of Divine Mercy" in re-
sponse to Saint Faustina Kowalska's Divine
Mercy devotion, which offered spiritual com-
fort to hearts worldwide. But Pope Francis
challenges us to make the comfort that we re-
ceive a gift we gladly share, saying that because
mercy was first shown to us we are therefore
called to show mercy ourselves. The clearest
expression of merciful love, says Francis, is
pardoning others. He acknowledges how diffi-
cult it can be to forgive sometimes, but if we
are to achieve peace in our hearts, pardon is
the tool that has been put into our very fallible
hands. The necessary condition for living joy-
fully? We must let go of anger, hatred, revenge,
and violence. A tall order in a world seemingly
bent on the destruction of every peaceful im-
pulse. May Divine Mercy Sunday remind us
that Jesus made mercy our life's ideal and a
criterion for our faith's credibility: "Blessed are
the merciful, for they will be shown mer-
cy" (Matthew 5:7).

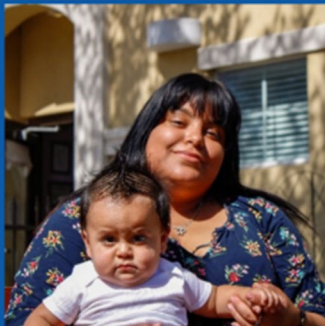
