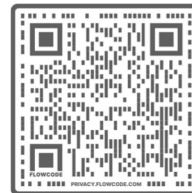

Liturgy of the Word

Continue.... What is the Lord telling me today? How should I improve my Christian life? We need faith, a faith that makes us who we are, Christians, followers of Christ. And it is a faith that we need to reaffirm once and again and again. That is why every Sunday we make **the Profession of our Faith** when we say, "I believe...". This profession of faith began when the first Christians communities had a new member who was baptized and who had to express his/her new faith publicly. But it was until the IV century that it was incorporated in the mass. So we do it after the readings and the homily to express that we believe in all the great works of God but also to express that we believe in the message of his Word. In the same way that we listen to God through the readings, God wants to hear us and so there is an important moment when we can express our needs, the needs of the Church and the needs of the world. So we finish the Liturgy of the Word by offering our petitions or **Intercessions**, always imploring God to listen to us through Christ our Lord. Also, known as the General Intercessions, these are prayers of the gathered faithful. In praying this prayer, the faithful are carrying out their role of praying for the entire world as well as for the needs of the local community. *Next Sunday, the Liturgy of the Eucharist*

Continúa... ¿Qué es lo que el Señor me dice hoy? ¿Cómo debo mejorar mi vida cristiana? Necesitamos fe, una fe que nos hace quienes somos, cristianos, seguidores de Cristo. Y es una fe que tenemos que reaffirmar una y otra vez y otra vez. Por esta razón todos los domingos hacemos la **Profesión de nuestra Fe** cuando decimos "Creo...". Esta profesión de fe comenzó cuando las primeras comunidades de cristianos acogían un nuevo miembro que era bautizado y que tenía que expresar públicamente su nueva fe. Pero fue hasta el siglo IV que fue incorporada en la misa. Por eso lo hacemos después de las lecturas y la homilía para expresar que creemos en las grandes obras de Dios pero también para expresar que creemos en el mensaje de su Palabra. Al igual que escuchamos a Dios a través de las lecturas, Dios quiere oírnos y por eso hay un momento importante cuando podemos expresar nuestras necesidades, las necesidades de la Iglesia y las necesidades del mundo. Así terminamos la Liturgia de la Palabra, ofreciendo nuestras peticiones o **Intercesiones**, siempre implorando a Dios para escucharnos a través de Cristo nuestro Señor. También conocidas como Intercesiones Generales, estas son oraciones de los fieles reunidos. Rezando esta oración, los fieles llevan a cabo su función de orar por todo el mundo, así como por las necesidades de la comunidad local. *El próximo domingo, la Liturgia de la Eucaristía*

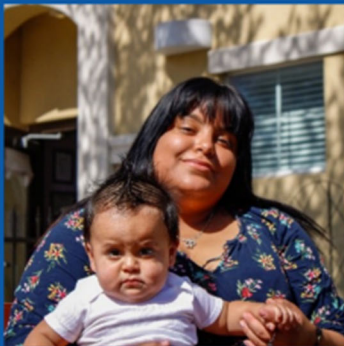
