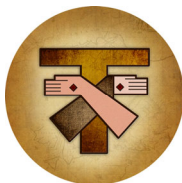
Students must attend 9am Mass with their family and will be dismissed after mass, and class will end at 11:30am. If you have any questions, please call the parish office.

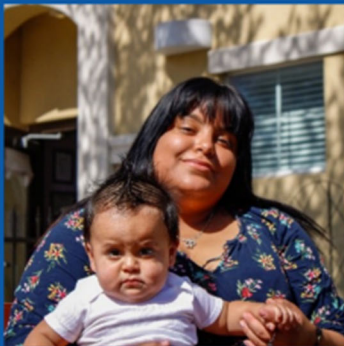
