Please join us for Movie Night on

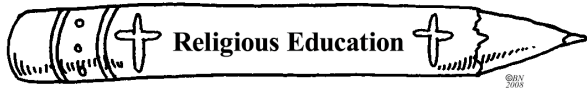
Wed., Nov. 29th.

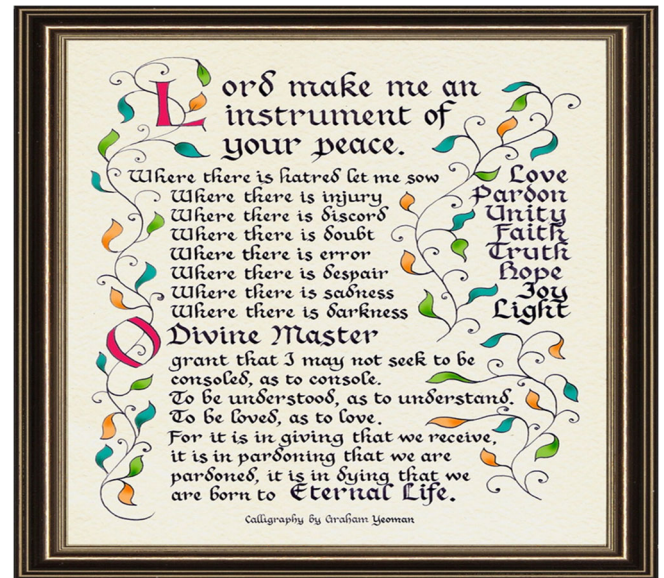

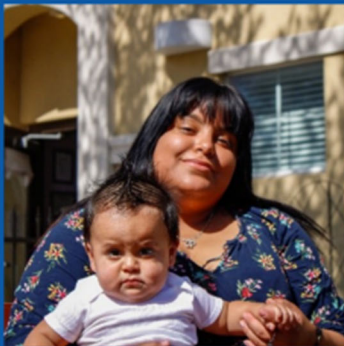
