"Ite, missa est."

If you are of a certain age, you might recall these words. When I was in third grade and learning how to serve Mass, this was one of the first Latin phrases that I knew by memory. I've been thinking of these words in the past few days. When the Mass was first given to us in English, this phrase was translated: "Go, the Mass is ended." The basic meaning is the same, but literally it should be translated: "Go, you are sent." There's a change in focus and direction in this translation. Instead of focusing on the Mass having ended, we are called to focus on where we are going.

This understanding is important to us. We are the parish of Mission San Jose; this weekend we celebrate Missionfest. We could look backward and say the Franciscans were sent here to build the mission, and celebrate that fact. And we should! The impact the mission made in its early days was immense. The friars walked throughout Nueva Espana, bringing the faith as well as skills for good living. If we concerned ourselves only with that, we would exist in a museum, drawing dust daily. But our life as a parish is much richer than that. We are a living church, the living body of Christ in this age. And so, we are sent as well. We are today's disciples of Christ who share in his life and his mission. How do we do this, practically? Good question!

Few, if any of us, have the vocation to be a missionary and go to far off lands. But all of us are called to be missionaries in this place and time, with all those we meet. "Preach the Gospel at all times; when necessary, use words." This sentence attributed to St. Francis is a model for us. We preach the Gospel by recognizing everyone as a son or daughter of God. We preach through the kindness we express when talking with the workers at the grocery store, or gas station, or barber shop/salon. Maintaining appropriate boundaries, we act with generosity, welcoming the stranger.

This is our Mission statement, as published on the front of every bulletin:

Mission San Jose Catholic Church was founded and established to proclaim the Gospel mission of Jesus for our time and place by becoming a faith community of God's people. Through a commitment to prayer, study, fellowship and ministry, we strive to become a community of hope to all around us and a living mission to the many who choose to come to Mission San Jose.

How do we individually and as a parish, bring these words to life? Let's explore this together throughout this year.

"Deo gratias." This is the response to "Ite, missa est." Thanks be to God, is our response. We have been nourished by the Bible and Eucharist, and we are energized to go forth and share the Good News of salvation, of life. (Although it could also be thanks that a boring homily is over!) May God give us the courage and resources to live our faith daily. May we live our mission in this world so that all might know God's love.

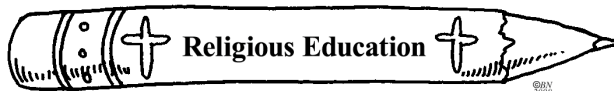
